SERIAL NUMBER BOOK

The 1st edition of our Serial Number Book was published during this quarter, and many Newsletter subscribers have ordered copies direct from us (price \$10). There were no numbered copies of this book, but I have written a personal note in each book bought direct by a subscriber; if this was not done for you, please feel free to return your book for this service.

This edition contains the serial numbers of approximately 46,500 weapons, most of which had been previously published in the Newsletters. Our plan is to continue to publish serial data in the Newsletters, putting out future editions of the Serial Number Book whenever sufficient data have been accumulated.

CIVIL WAR CARBINES AND REVOLVERS

We have found a substantial quantity of serial numbers in the AGO records for the Civil War period, so we have commenced recording this data for use in a book to be published about three years hence. This book will be organized along the lines of our Serial Number Book, with each of the 30 or more varieties of weapons assigned a separate section containing production data, a list of the organizations who used that weapon, and a tabulation of serial number data. Each variety of weapon will be illustrated, and weapons with known provenance will be shown where possible. Serial numbers will be listed in the Newsletter as we find them, and subscribers are invited to submit photos of any listed weapons. All who submit photos will be furnished with an authenticating letter; in addition, persons submitting photos actually used will be given a free copy of the book. If you need guidance on photographing guns, please write for our free information sheet on this subject.

TRAPDOOR DATA

Trapdoor serial data reported in this issue consists mainly of Indian War-era rifles and carbines, together with a pair of Model 1888 rifles of Span-Am War usage.

The list includes 22 carbines turned in as unserviceable by the 7th Cavalry following the Battle of Little Bighorn. These and other arms turned in by units within the Dept. of Dakota were examined by Capt. Michaelis, the chief Ordnance Officer, who submitted a report to the Chief of Ordnance and then shipped the arms to Springfield Armory in August, 1877. Another 45 7th Cavalry carbines were shipped to Rock Island Arsenal for examination, but we have not yet found the serial numbers of those.

Telegrams exchanged by Gens. Sherman and Sheridan in Oct., 1877, indicate that many 7th Cavalry arms surrendered by Crazy Horse's band after the battle were loaned to the Arapahoes for use in hunting while they were being resettled. The Adjutant General stated that these arms consisted of 104 carbines and 38 pistols.

MODEL 1881 SHOTGUN SERIAL NUMBER RANGE

John Michel reports that he has observed a Model 1881 shotgun with serial no. 1378, which is a few numbers past the highest number previously reported.

TRAPDOOR GUN SLINGS

There are many trapdoor gun slings in existence which appear to have been made of two pieces of leather sewn together. We found information indicating that the original sling for the trapdoor rifle was 46" in length; and that starting in 1877, many of these short slings were lengthened to 70" at Watervliet Arsenal.

SPRINGFIELD PRODUCTION SUMMARY - 1877


An extract from the Report of Principal Operations at Springfield for fiscal year 1877 is included in this issue. The extensive list of experiments gives a good picture of the important activities at Springfield during this period.

FREUND IMPROVEMENT TO THE TRAPDOOR

The drawing on the following page shows another improvement made by F. W. Freund to the trapdoor breech mechanism with the same objective (i. e., preventing discharge before the breechblock was completely closed) as that shown in Newsletter no. 18. This modification consists basically of extending the breechblock rearward so that it would interfere with

or be cammed down by the hammer in case it should fall before the breech-block was fully closed. Freund stated that Gen. Crook was using a rifle in the field to which this modification had been made.

KRAG DATA

Krag serial data in this issue includes several Rough Rider carbines that we failed to list in the Serial Number Book, plus Model 1898 rifles of another company of Span-Am War volunteers and a few miscellaneous arms. The Rough Rider number listed as "6805X" is either 68051 or 68057.

ANOTHER INTERESTING KRAG CARBINE


The Model 1896 carbine whose receiver is shown below is listed as one turned in for renovation and rebrowning by Troop I, 9th Cavalry, in June, 1900. Several of the carbines listed along with no. 28683 were subsequently shown as having been reissued to the 12th Cavalry, so this probably explains the "12" marking on the receiver; but what does "P2" mean? Any ideas and/or reports on other carbines with similar markings would be appreciated.



MODEL 1903 RIFLE DATA

The Model 1903 rifles listed in this issue consist mainly of miscellaneous rifles cited in Ordnance Dept. records between 1905 and 1961. The most significant of these are no. 75170, which was one of the first of the cal. .22 Gallery Practice rifles; and no. 378268, which was used in testing of the Bassell and Blenkner rear sight. The Bassell & Blenkner sight (see illustration below) was seriously considered for adoption by the Ordnance Dept., and it was scheduled to be demonstrated at the 1911 National Matches.

Also listed are the serial numbers of more International Match rifles. These numbers, which were published in the May, 1927, issue of The American Rifleman, were furnished by Burt Kellerstedt.



COLT SINGLE ACTION ARMY REVOLVER DATA

On the next page are listed the few Colt SAA revolvers on which data were found during this period. The 7th Cavalry revolvers listed were turned in as unserviceable together with the trapdoor carbines described above.

We have been corresponding with Wiley Sword on the subject of Custer Colt serial ranges. Sword was quoted by E. Dixon Larson in the Dec. 17, 1981, issue of Gun Week as having stated, based on research of the Springfield Armory records, that the serial number range of Custer Colts was from 4516 to 5521. It turns out that Sword's estimates are based entirely on records of production, procurement, and issuances. In our experience, estimates based on such factors tend to understate serial

number ranges. We feel that our position is confirmed in this case by the fact that records we have found so far of 7th Cavalry Colts range from 5637 to 6559, which is about 1000 higher than Sword's estimates.

Other interesting SAAs listed are the three model arms produced in 1877. One of these (no. 33220) is illustrated on pg. 250 of Sutherland and Wilson's Book of Colt Firearms.

Finally, four Rough Rider SAAs that escaped inclusion in the 1st edition of our Serial Number Book are listed. The serial number of one of these (no. 189503) is considerably higher than that of the highest martial SAA known, but this is the number actually recorded.
