





Miscellaneous News and Notes

Research During This Period

Reviewing the Civil War hospital records, which had been found to contain serial number data for some units, was our most time-consuming activity. It produced little additional information, but we found the numbers of 72 more Henry rifles and added data on Maynard carbines and Pettingill revolvers from other Civil War records.

M1917 Rifle Stock Tip Marks

The records of the Machine Gun-Small Arms Section, Engineering Div., yielded a list of identification marks assigned by the Inspection Division on Dec. 14, 1918, to be used on M1917 guns stocks by the several manufacturers.

It was noted that "RI" was already being used by Rock Island Arsenal, and "E" by Eddystone. The following additional marks were assigned, to be $\frac{1}{4}$ " high and placed on the "front end" of the stock:

Remington Arms U.M.C. Bridgeport	"B"

Books Reviewed

Wayne Gagner reviewed Clark Campbell's latest book, *The '03 Era*, with the main object of determining whether it contains enough new or revised information to make it worthwhile to '03 collectors who have one of his earlier books. Wayne concluded that the additional information on the USMC Sniper Rifle, commercial sporters, and ammunition definitely make it worthwhile. See the ad on pg. 79-9 for ordering information.

Scott Duff submitted his ring-bound book describing *The Guam Garands*, thirty M1 rifles which had been turned over to the Local Security Patrol Force at the end of WWII. The story of the history and restoration of these rifles is very interesting, and there is a data sheet on each of the rifles. These rifles have

been sold since being brought back to the mainland U.S.

A note from Joe Poyer states that a thorough review will be made of the *M1 Garand Book, 1936-1957* to correct the errors pointed out in our Issue 78 and others, before it is reprinted.

Harrington & Richardson Serial Number Records

We obtained two microfilms that supposedly contain the shipment records on M1 rifles made by H&R; however, the only M1 records are for what should be Springfield M1s in the ranges 6034331—6034649 and 784398—799126. Drop me a line if you know what these are. The microfilms also contain delivery records on Reisings, M14 rifles, British WWII contract revolvers, and Leatherneck .22 rifles.

Post-WWII Springfield Armory Records

I went through some of these back in 1985; they are still in St. Louis, awaiting their turn to be reviewed by archivists to determine what should be acquired by the National Archives and sent to Washington or (more likely) Waltham.

The National Park Service is now attempting to have these records transferred back to Springfield Armory. This would be a very beneficial move for arms researchers, because it would preserve a lot of material that would otherwise be discarded.

Civil War Regiment and Company Books

The National Archives has resumed the project, started last year, to better organize and preserve these valuable Civil War records by boxing each volume (approx. 8,700). This work is being done on a state-by-state basis, and it is resulting in all records for a given state (currently Illinois) being made inaccessible to researchers for a month or more at a time.

More OSS Records

Probably the final transfer of OSS records from the CIA, consisting of about 300 boxes, was completed last month. All have been declassified, and the CIA also turned over all individual files which had been withheld previously. All OSS records have been moved to Archives II in College Park, Md.

Tin Plated Ward-Burton; VMI Muskets

I have a Ward Burton Carbine that every metal part, (springs, screws, barrel, butt plate and screws, etc.) both inside and out, has been tin plated. Could this have been done for the Navy? I can find no reference that a Ward-Burton was ever used by the Navy or was ever "tinned". Just by the fact that all of the metal parts were tinned I would not think that this had been done for appearance as in a parade rifle, but as protection as the Navy might do.

I would appreciate any help you or any MAC reader could offer about this piece.

Sorry, I have nothing on nickel or tin plating of Ward Burton arms. But they were made at a time when nickel plating was much in vogue; possibly a few were plated for display in some exhibition. Also, a half dozen Ward Burton carbines were sold to a man named Whipple. Possibly he had some plated. I have nothing on Navy usage of this arm.

Also could you point me to where I could find any information on 1852 VMI Muskets (1851 dated).

Likewise, I have nothing on the sale of Model 1851 Cadet muskets to VMI; however, I have done little research in that time period.

The information, if it exists, could probably be found at the National Archives under RG 156, Entry 21, in files starting with either "V" or the initial of the last name of the Governor of Virginia at that time.

An article in the Oct., 1986 edition of The American Rifleman states that VMI turned over their "U.S. percussion cadet muskets" (presumably Model 1851) to "senior troops in need of arms" at the start of the Civil War; consequently, the Battle of New Market found the Cadets armed with Austrian muskets.

"Date of Manufacture"

In your serial # books, you list the date of manufacture. Is that the first time the gun was assembled, or is it a rebuild date? I ask this because it seems that many manufacturing dates are much later than the estimated year of manufacture of the receiver.

I don't know where you are getting the estimated date of manufacture of the receiver. But in our serial number books, the estimated serial number at start of year for M1903 and M1922 rifles is based on fiscal year data released by the Ordnance Dept., adjusted to give the approximate serial number at start of calendar year. The Ordnance Dept. numbers are thought to represent the first rifle completed and ready for turnover to the Ordnance Storekeeper on July 1 of a given year. Because rifles were not assembled in serial number order, some rifles completed later had serial numbers thousands lower. Consequently, this data gives the earliest date at which a rifle could have been originally completed; it has nothing to do with rebuild dates.

I have a Civil War sniper rifle with the eagle and the serial number #956 that is the one I am actively pursuing at the moment. I notice that Mr. Fagen has one a few numbers away from mine, so I am in hopes I can catch up on the paperwork and find out to whom 956 was issued.

The maker is R. R. Moore of Cincinatus, N. Y., not Dimick of St. Louis, so I am really confused now as to whether Dimick took existing guns off the open market to fulfill his contract; plus the fact that this gun is a finely made double side by side rifle. Confusing, to say the least.

We have no information on no. 956 in the Dimick series, so we couldn't furnish the information on this rifle even if it was one of those rifles.

I have no information on R. R. Moore; and while it is thought that Dimick relied on other makers to furnish some of his sniper rifles, it seems logical that he would have specified the same type rifle (i.e., single barrel). I am forwarding this to Mr. Fagen for his comments.

Another 2-band Model 1866 Rifle

In issue no. 77 of the Newsletter, R.H. in California has inquired about the ramrod used on the short, 2-band Model 1866 rifle. You already have some information on my own rifle but I will submit more specifics. The rod is 34.88" long with a serrated, slotted, cupped head and is threaded at the other end. The rod is straight, no swelling, and measures .214" in diameter. When fully seated against the lower ramrod stop, the rod is .80" recessed in from the muzzle.

The stock does not have a band spring patch and does not contain an upper ramrod stop. It does have the retaining spoon and the lower rod stop is not threaded. The lockplate carries an 1862 date and the breech block has the double lightening cuts that one observes on the '67 cadet rifle. Three cartouches are noticeable on the stock in the customary place. It does not have the "screw-in keeper". The lower rod stop is present and is discernible in the inletting under the trigger guard. Probing the rod channel back to the stop with a thin wire also indicates no threading.

There appears to be much individuality in the production and trimming down of these rifles.

R.H. has reported an excellent set of dimensions. Adding my own to the same format, we have for comparison purposes:

I double-checked the "F" dimension. The barrel length, of course, includes the breech section.

Although not exactly similar to R.H.'s 2 bander, the info should provide at least some

measure of guidance.

11-05 RIA Barrel

Bruce Canfield's article "ROCK ISLAND: THE OTHER '03" published in the 2/96 issue of Man At Arms states:

"On December 20, 1904 Rock Island Arsenal's first M1903 rifle, serial number 1, was assembled."

I have a stripped barrel marked R.I.A./-Ordnance Bomb/11-04 on top at the muzzle.

Overall length is exactly 24 inches. It is chambered for the .30-'06 cartridge.

The raised spline on the top front, at muzzle (for the front sight "fixed stud") and the raised portion over which the front sight fixed stud fits, is 3/4" in length. Not the 1" as found on the M1903 Ramrod Bayonet Rifle, and not the 7/8" as found on the later 1905 type front sight. The hole in the spline, through which a pin secures the front sight fixed stud to the barrel, is located 1/8" back from the FRONT of the spline.....unlike the M1903 RRB Rifle spline hole which is located in the CENTER of the spline.....and unlike the later 1905 type spline hole which is located 1/8" forward from the REAR of the spline.

The later 1905 type rear sight fixed base (sleeve) fits the barrel perfectly. The hole in the fixed base (sleeve) through which a pin passes into a matching groove in the BOTTOM of the barrel, are in perfect alignment. There is no sign of another groove which is found in those barrels which have been modified from the 1903-03 to the 1903-05 configuration.

This data is presented in hopes that someone specializing in the M1903's can supply the answers to some questions which, to me, beg to be answered:

1. If the M1903 RRB Rifle barrels manufactured at Springfield were not marked/dated 1905 until 1905, why were they marked/dated at R.I.A. in 1904? Or, putting it another way, if the standard practice at R.I.A. was to mark/date barrels in 1904, why wasn't that same practice followed at Springfield? (Note that the early marked R.I.A. barrel is marked with the month and the year, while the Springfield barrels are marked only with the year. Why?).

2. Extant 1905 dated Springfield barrels were

initially chambered for the M1903-03 cartridge and later modified to 1903-06. Was the date added at the time of conversion, or at the time of original manufacture, for the M1903 RRB Rifle? This is important because if it was the latter, appropriately serial numbered M1903 RRB Rifles would properly have barrels dated 1905. In other words, not all M1903 RRB Rifles should have undated barrels, which is....as I understand it....the current wisdom.

3. Why would a R.I.A. barrel manufactured in November, 1904 be chambered for the 1906 cartridge and externally configured for changes not officially mandated until much later, in 1905?

4. What explains the configuration of the front sight mounting which is unlike both the M1903 RRB Rifle and the later M1903-05 Rifle?

The reply below is from C.S. "Nick" Ferris:

Your early Rock Island Arsenal Model 1903 rifle barrel dated November 1904 and now chambered in .30-'06 is a good example of some of the alterations described by John Beard and myself in "Springfield Model 1903 Service Rifle Production and Alteration 1905-1910".

First, the barrel date. While RIA serial No. 1 was indeed assembled 20 December 1904, numerous parts were manufactured at RIA for several months prior to assembly of the first rifle. In my book, "The Rock Island '03", I mention a barrel dated October 1904. Your barrel was made for a rod bayonet rifle. Assembly of these was stopped at RIA and SA in January 1905. In May 1905 a knife bayonet to replace the rod bayonet was approved, resulting in a small but important barrel and front sight change. The Model 1905 rear sight was adopted July or August 1905. At about this time, preparations were made at RIA and SA to stamp barrels with the place and date of manufacture. When rod bayonet rifles, and unassembled barrels, were altered to later con-

figuration they were retroactively stamped with the familiar marks, e.g., RIA/ordnance escutcheon (bomb)/11-04. Springfield made rod gun barrels in 1903 and 1904, but all are marked simply SA/ordnance escutcheon/05.

Regarding the spline and front sight, let me elaborate a bit. When it was decided to adopt the Model 1905 knife bayonet, the rifle barrel at the muzzle had to fit within the bayonet's barrel ring. This required setting the front sight fixed stud farther back and machining away the front of the spline (lug) which was an integral part of the barrel. Actually, a new stud was used, not the rod gun stud, or fixed base. This resulted in a small rectangular hole appearing at the rear of the front sight stud where it extended back past the spline. Because the spline was absent at this point, the transverse securing pin was put thru the front of the front sight stud, instead of thru the rear as in all barrels made after May 1905.

Rock Island made barrels in late 1904 and possibly as late as April or May 1905 before turning to what we call the 1905 Modification Rifle. Because rod gun assembly ceased in January, and RIA consequently had assembled very few rod bayonet rifles, there were many RIA barrels without sights and not assembled to rifles. In contrast, SA had assembled about 74,000 rod bayonet rifles. It happens that the transverse grooves in the top of barrels where the front and rear fixed sight bases were attached were not drilled until the bases were put on. Barrels not assembled do not, therefore, have the grooves. Grooves in rod gun barrels are now obscured by later model sight fixed bases and studs but can be discovered by x-ray. They are more common on SA barrels.

The groove you speak of in the bottom of your barrel is the one made when the rear sight fixed base was applied during alteration for 1906 ammunition, after the barrel had been set back 0.20 inch. The rod gun rear sight base would have a groove across the top of the barrel which is obscured by the Model 1905 fixed base, and a 1905 modification rifle barrel would now show the extra groove between bands of the old style 1905 rear sight fixed base after alteration for

Model 1906 ammunition. Very, very few rod guns were altered to the 1905 modification and altered again to the 1906 configuration.

So, your RIA 11-04 barrel, originally made for the rod bayonet rifle, probably was never actually assembled to one; rather, it was one of the 18,000 sets of parts left unassembled until after alteration for the Model 1906 cartridge. Much of this alteration and final assembly took place in late 1907 and 1908 (even later where SA rifles are concerned). This 1904 barrel's first appearance on a completed rifle would typically involve a 1905 or 1906 receiver and a stock cartouched in 1908 --- and this would be absolutely correct.

Detailed accounts of these and other alteration features, with plenty of illustrations, appear in the "Alterations" book by John Beard and me. If your local news stand is fresh out, I'll send one for \$12.50 plus \$2.00 shipping.

Colt Super .38s in England

Saw an interesting tidbit that might be worth you following up. Especially in light of your recent expeditions regarding .38 Supers.

Collector Grade Publications has a new book out by an author named Hill, dealing with the history of the Thompson SMG. In a chapter on British use, he mentions the existence of "HOME GUARD SPECIAL UNITS". Apparently, these HGSU's rated quite highly, because they received Thompsons first, followed by the Commandos and then the regular army. The HGSU were to stage a guerilla war against the Germans after the invasion of England. To accomplish this, each unit had a secret arms and explosives cache "...They were issued Colt .38 Super automatics and transit chests filled with fully accessorized 1928 Savage Thompsons, ready to load and shoot...".

While on the subject of secret arms caches, I attach the following article: AP 26 Jan 96 16:17 EST V0654

[copyrighted article on secret arms and ammunition caches left by the U.S. in Austria to be used by partisans in the event of a Communist takeover]

A later version of this article identifies some of the guns as "pistols with sound suppressors". Perhaps this explains why so many Colt Hammerlesses were purchased but relatively few have surfaced.

That's interesting. I haven't seen anything else on Super .38s, but there is some more OSS material I will be going through, and maybe something else will turn up.

I assume that "pistols with sound suppressors" refers to High Standard .22s, rather than Colts; the Colt Pocket Hammerless automatic was judged to be unsuitable for silencing. Nearly all the approx. 2,500 suppressed pistols made by High Standard were delivered to the OSS, and it makes sense that the OSS would have been involved in the establishment of secret arms caches in Austria and other European countries; however, I saw nothing on this in the admittedly cursory examination I made of the OSS files.

Canadian Warner & Swazey Sights; "MD" M1878 Colts

With respect to my comments on Warner & Swazey sights in Canadian service during WWII. These were units purchased for the Great War and pressed back into service in 1939.

Regarding D.T.'s inquiry on M1878 Colts. The "155/MD/C" are marks that indicate Canadian issue. Between 1885 - 1902, the government purchased 1,001 of these from various sources. Many of the "MD" marked guns ("Militia & Defence") purchased for the 1885 Rebellion were loaned to the North-West Mounted Police. Additional units, some blue but all in 45LC and with 7 1/2" bbl. by regulation, were purchased during the South African War. Upon return, most were heavily refinished in nickel; these were then re-issued during the Great War. D.T.'s pistol's (Cdn.) numbers and "C" mark - possibly a poorly struck property mark - are standard. As for the 5 1/2" barrel, D.T.'s may have been re-barreled; or there is a remote chance that one purchased in haste had an adequate - but short - barrel.

I suggest Canadian Military Handguns 1855-1985, by Clive M. Law (ISBN 0-88855-008-1); Ch. 3 and Appendix E as a reference on these.

Problems with New '03 Book

I feel that it is only right that readers of Springfield Research know that I am in NO WAY connected with the gross and almost unbelievably blatant errors of fact that permeate Harrison's Collecting the '03 Springfield, a copy of which I first saw only last week. Billed as a "Collector's Field Guide", it is 5½" x 8½", spiral bound, and consists, principally, of some 39 presentations of rifle drawings opposite "key identification features" on facing pages. He has been getting \$25.00 retail for this thoroughly misleading "Guide"!

He mentions Brophy in his Preface, but apparently didn't so much as look at the pictures therein, as he says, repeatedly, that the coarsely checkered NM buttplate had "NO trap", and he depicts and describes the M1903A3 (National Match) as having a C stock with milled hardware, milled guard, Lyman 48 rear sight, and Lyman 17A front!!

He mentions me, too, in the Preface and has, in addition, put the earlier 1971 edition of my The '03 Era (then The '03 Springfield) in his very scant Bibliography, whereas it appears to be his sole source for most of the arms referenced.

In truth, he took my rifle drawings for his use, altering a good part of them and making them thereby incorrect — such as adding the Ordnance Escutcheon stamp to the stocks of pre-WWII rifles from 1905 on; adding the 48 Lyman to National Match rifles; and moving the Style T rear scope block onto the barrel. Otherwise, he has virtually disregarded my text, and his imaginative nomenclatures, in particular, had no source in my book.

In short, Springfield Research readers should not "tar with the same brush" either the long out-of-print and admittedly imperfect The '03 Springfields or my 1994 extensively revised and expanded edition, The '03 Era—When Smokeless Revolutionized U.S. Riflery, which is thoroughly revised and incorporates throughout much additional material and some very significant new insights developed from the many rich sources developed in the last twenty years, to include, for example, the documents quoted by Brophy; U.S. Weapons Developments, 1920-25; U.S.M.C. files re WWII sniper rifles sent me by Ken Kogan; and

Mallory's Record of DCM Rifle Sales. (The latter was crucial, for example, in establishing that the 2,625 heavy barrel rifles produced from fiscal 1925 through fiscal 1929 were, actually, Style T, rather than Match Springfield, M1922).

There is some information that may be of interest. The bottom paragraph on page 2 talks about RIA stocks left over from WWI. If what he says is true, they used HORSE PISS to season these stocks. Perhaps we should start washing our hands more frequently!!

REMEMBERING WORLD WAR II

[Mr. Kendall worked in the Shipping Dept. at Remington Ilion, and most portions of his article concerned with shipping have been deleted. He was also a cartoonist for the plant newsletter, and this job apparently exposed him to operations throughout the plant.]

At times the line would stop due to problems in the assembly of the rifle. I would then start drawing cartoons of happenings at the plant. Unbeknown to me, they were turned over to Mr. Rostahar who took them to the Publicity Manager and the Editor of the Reming-

ton Action. They soon had me doing cartoons and posters for the Action and war effort. Much of this I did during my lunch hour at mid-night.

We had a crew of four men who loaded freight cars and trucks, two men to weigh, mark addresses on boxes and cartons, then keep a written record of everything entering the shipping room. The night shift needed just the two men to take care of the conveyor.

The commercial part of the plant made shotguns for the Air Force. The young pilots were trained on a circular track, sitting in cars that sped around on the track and as it went they practiced shooting at targets with the shotguns. Once a month the guns were sent back to be repaired; and if Commercial didn't return them on time, they would be fined.

The blank stocks brought from the Rock Island arsenal were there since the end of World War I. They all had to be put in the dry kilns to season and moisture contents brought to a certain level. The old method took six months to do the job. A young chemist had discovered that by using the urine from horses on the stock blank it took only a month. Every day he was down with his instruments and into the kilns to check, a job we didn't envy him. One can say even the horses contributed to the war effort.

It took ten different operations to turn out one stock ready to be assembled with other parts to make a complete rifle. Later, Remington came out with a machine that took care of the ten different operations. This took one man to do what ten were doing.

The rifle parts started in the steel room on the first floor, barrels cut to length turned down on lathes, bored and grooved to allow the bullet to start spinning on the way to a target. Inspected by Remington and then Ordnance before being sent to the next operation. The bolt action was shaped by drop hammers as was the breech where the bullet stopped before being injected into the barrel. All these parts including the trigger guards had to go to the filers who filed excess metal to shape the parts, then buffed them smooth. Later Remington came up with using strips of metal bent to shape for trigger guards and other parts of the rifle. Eventually with ideas from employees who were given awards if the idea was used, the cost of rifles came down from \$100 to \$50 each. The screws, scopes, and bayonets used came from other manufacturers. Union Fork and Hoe supplied the bayonets and were busy developing radar detectors.

The stocks after finishing were dipped in a very thin solution of varnish five times. This method was devel-

oped for the commercial stocks and resisted chipping as the varnish was absorbed by the wood. The rifle then went to be test fired with a heavy load to see if it would stand up to field use. After that, ten rifles from each shipment were dismantled, parts put in a pile and rebuilt. If this failed, parts were checked for specification as ten cases of each part accompanied a shipment to make sure guns could be repaired at the area of action.

The guns were sent to the packing room, dismantled and dipped in an oily solution to protect them from moisture of any kind. They were wrapped in water-proof paper and packed ten to a case.

One time the packer was taking out the bolt action to grease and it came out of the breech without releasing a safety catch. Production was stopped; and as we had three shipments on the floor to go, a crew of workers were sent to open the cases and inspect every rifle. Those O.K. were repacked and cases sealed. At the end, they found no other faulty safety catch. This only happened twice that a faulty part passed Remington and Ordnance inspectors, who had the last say.

At this time 10,000 employees were turning out the M1, and auto dealers with no cars to sell were producing gun boxes.

Remington produced the M1 with a scope and most were sent to the Pacific area. At times the ordnance inspector and I were given secret instructions to address 15 to 30 cases of scope rifles, wrap them in heavy paper and seal, address to a west coast base, take them to Syracuse airport for shipment and stay with them until placed on the plane and it took off.

Women and men did a wonderful job producing arms for the boys overseas. It was also found that elderly workers were very reliable especially on Mondays. The best engraver Remington had was a female. During the war she was on guard duty.

Remington gun designers developed the semi-automatic but Springfield Armory was set up for that type of rifle and given the order to produce them.

If anyone gets to Ilion, N.Y. and is given permission to view their collection of guns and pistols from antique to modern, it is well worth while.

It does seem that Kendall has confused the M1903 rifle with the M1; also note his confusing the cutoff with the safety in describing the problem which occurred with bolt removal while greasing one of the rifles. His statement about Remington gun designers developing the semi-automatic has a kernel of truth in it: Rem-

ington was the first American manufacturer to offer semi-automatic shotguns and rifles to sportsmen. And John D. Pedersen was at one time a Remington gun designer. But of course, neither can be credited with development of the M1 Garand rifle.

Also, I don't understand why it would have been necessary to season stocks blanks that had been produced for WWI, some 23 years earlier. It makes a good story, tho.

The "secret instructions" to ship M1903A4 rifles probably pertained to shipments to the OSS.

How about seeing if you can find copies of the "Remington Action" for the war years? ☺

U.S. Small Arms as Seen by Troops in the Field, 1899-1901

by John Spangler

Collectors recognize the numerous changes in sights and other details of U.S. military rifles and pistols of the Spanish-American War period, and can recite when they were made. They know that additional cavalry sabers were ordered from Ames in 1906. Of course, the Model 1909 revolver restored the use of .45 caliber ammunition after two decades with various .38 caliber pistols. Collectors often form opinions about early arms based on their own military experience, plus shooting and hunting experience with newer arms developed dozens of years later.

Collectors also tend to be picky about condition of arms and some dislike examples that are less than pristine, and object to specimens that have any missing parts or worn finish.

But what did the men who carried the arms on active service think of them, and what changes did they recommend? What was the condition of the arms while they were actually being used? Here are some comments made shortly after the Spanish American War, as reported by various Inspectors General from U.S. occupation troops in Cuba and Puerto Rico, and those putting down the insurrection by the recently liberated Filipinos.¹

SMALL ARMS.

Colonel Garlington [Philippines]: "The rifle and carbine have given universal satisfaction. On arms of the older issue [.45-70s], the Buffington sight is very generally condemned on account of the impossibility, under service conditions, to adjust the slide."

Maj. R. A. Brown [Philippines]: "The United States magazine rifle and carbine have continued to give satisfaction, and complaint regarding them has been entirely absent. The sight, however, on the arms of older issue [.45-70s], is condemned almost universally. As it becomes worn, it is simply impossible to secure the slide for the range, or even when less worn, if it is desired to change the sight to suit the changed range after the weapon has been in use, if is impossible, on account of the heating of the sight, to secure the slide at the new range desired. Many of the rifles in the hands of the troops are practically unserviceable for good shooting on that account."

Major Sharpe [Porto Rico]: "A shorter and lighter rifle might be issued to infantry serving in the Tropics, and it might also be conveniently carried by cavalry."


Colonel Burton [Cuba]: "The general consensus

of opinion is that the carbine should have a finer front sight, the rear sight to be provided with wind gauge and automatic correction for drift and with a full length jointed cleaning rod."

Major Johnston [Philippines]: "The United States magazine rifle and carbine are above complaint in their perfect state. The wind gauge of the Buffington sight is a desirable feature, but the rear sight slide screws are frequently lost, and it seems impossible to obtain spare parts for repairs. I have seldom inspected a company in which several guns had not been rendered unserviceable by loss or breaking of parts. Cosmolene has not been issued in sufficient quantities and the use of cocoa oil on metallic parts has eaten off the bronzing [sic] and lead to rust. Some companies have used emory paper on metallic parts. For mounted duty some [stacking] swivels have been removed from the upper bands to permit the piece to enter carbine scabbards freely, thus rendering it inconvenient to stack arms when members of the mounted detachments are with their companies. For all service in the Philippines the carbine is more serviceable than the rifle; it is lighter, can be carried in the scabbard mounted, and its range is equally good for the character of service required. The bayonet is thoroughly useless; can not be used as an intrenching tool, even if this guerrilla war justified intrenching, and it renders the load of the foot soldier unwieldy. Moreover, if carried in the field, the scabbard frequently breaks off and the bayonet is lost. For guard post duty it may add a little to the formidable appearance of a sentinel; but I have seen no company where bayonet exercise is practiced. The sentinel could defend himself better with a shot from a carbine, and the saving of weight is of the greatest importance in scouts where thick brush must be penetrated, and it is necessary to crawl as carefully upon insurgent quartels [sic] as upon wild game. The carbine of 1899 with [Parkhurst] clip feed for the magazine is excellent."

Colonel Burton [Cuba]: "The sentiment throughout the cavalry service in Cuba is for an increased caliber for the pistol. They agree that the present [.38 caliber] pistol has no stopping power and that it carries unnecessarily far. The general recommendation is that the caliber should be increased above .45 rather than decreased, and that the ball should be driven with sufficient force to be effective at 75 or 100 yards. They claim that the pistol to be effective has to depend upon its shock action; that, being used ordinarily at short ranges, unless it is of such caliber and construction as


to place an enemy *hors de combat*, its usefulness is seriously impaired. It is suggested that consideration of this subject be taken up during the present test of rapid-firing pistols."



71st N.Y. Volunteers boarding transport U.S.A.T. Vigilancia, 1898. Scribner's Collection (Army).




Showing the manner our Army was landed at Daquiri, Cuba. Scribner's Collection (Army).

Major Sharpe [Porto Rico]: "Some cavalry officers have expressed to me the opinion that the saber should be abandoned as a weapon. Its future usefulness in war is doubtful, especially where troops are well trained in the use of the revolver. The saber, however, may continue to be used in calisthenic exercises."


