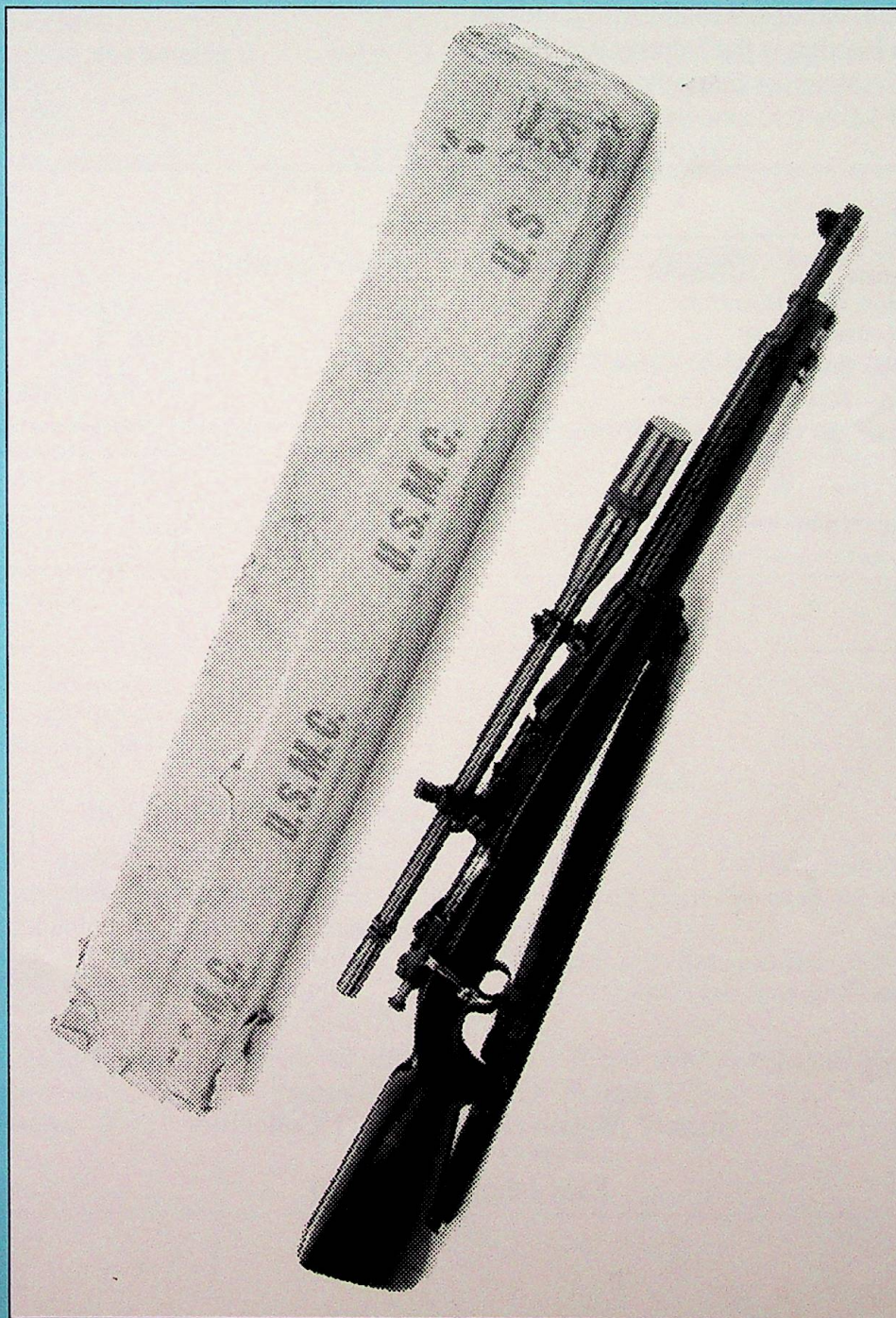

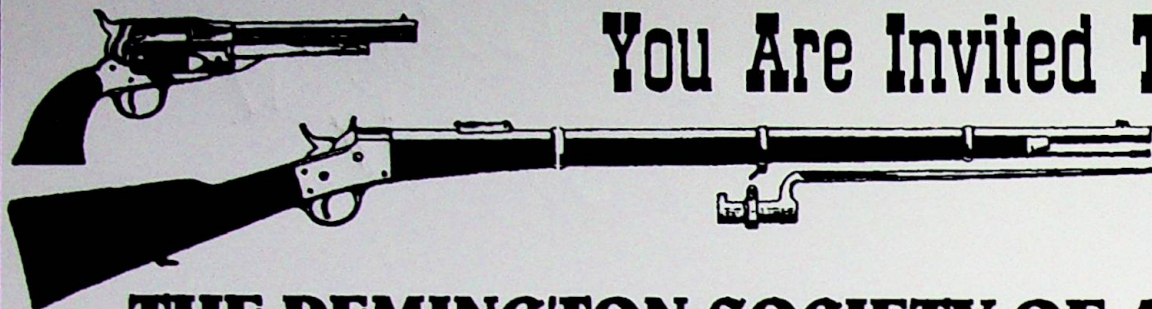

## Miscellaneous News and Notes

### Research During This Period

Most of the research during this period was in the Navy and Army ordnance records. We found a very useful memo from 1929 describing early Garand and Pedersen rifles and assigning standard nomenclatures.

We added about 10,000 entries to the serial number data bases: 8,700 M1 rifles, 1,000 M1917 rifles, and the rest Civil War and miscellaneous. Significant numbers include cal. .276 Garand, Pedersen, and M1903 rifles.

The bulk of M1 serial numbers were for rifles manufactured by H&R and delivered to Anniston or Pueblo Ordnance Depots in 1956 and 1957. Scott Duff furnished contract information for the H&R rifles in the 6034331-6034649 range; but we still have no information on those in the 784398—799126 range, except that it appears they had receivers marked "Springfield Armory". Any information on observed guns in this range would be appreciated.

## Letters Received & Sent

### Long Range Rifle Barrel Markings

I picked up a pricey trapdoor rarity: a .45-80 long range rifle, serial no. 162424. It has the six groove barrel with very narrow lands and the Hotchkiss buttplate. It also has a Bull rear sight with a windage knob. There is no tang sight on the rifle nor is there a wooden pistol grip. The stock cartouche is SWP and 1881 which is correct for a long range rifle of this configuration. I held my breath when I fitted the 2.4 inch long-case .45-80-500 cartridge into the gun but it chambered nicely. One other point of interest: the old-style trigger is grooved with coarse vertical grooves.

The 1881 Annual Report of the Chief of Ordnance, Appendix 1, Class VI lists 151 Springfield rifles, long range, caliber .45 as having been fabricated for that fiscal year and mine is undoubtedly one of these. A limited number of others were produced in the two prior years but they are not listed separately in the respective annual reports. Their production can be found in the two trapdoor books.

The only unanswered question I have concerning the rifle is the meaning of the letters, "HGR", stamped on the barrel, between the receiver and the Bull sight. "HR", I understand, can also be located here. Found one sub-inspector with the initials: "HR", but his era of activity was sixty years later. Could the lettering denote the unusual nature of the barrel itself, such as Hexagonal Rifling, Hexagonal Groove Rifling, or even Hexa-Groove Rifling? That, or a yet to be discovered inspector. Any comments would be appreciated.

*I don't know what these markings mean; but I have two other candidates for meanings of "H" and "G", based on rifling experiments in 1881: "H" for "Henry", and "G" for "gain (twist)". The latter can be determined by inspecting the rifling from the breech to see if it has the same apparent twist as when viewed from the muzzle.*

Select-fire M1911A1 Pistols

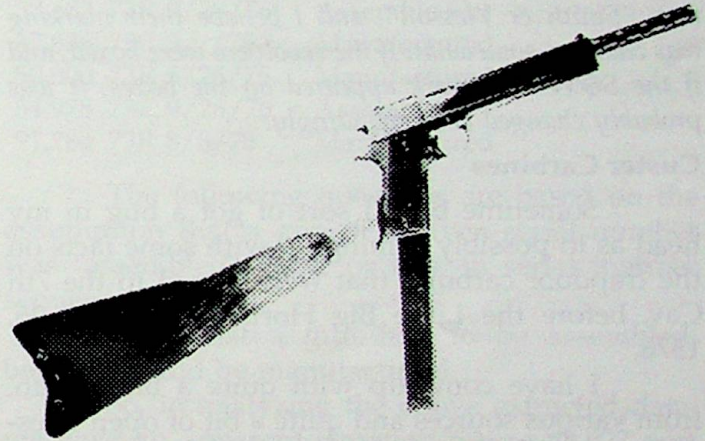
I have been doing a little research into Colt's involvement with a select-fire M1911A1 .45 and .38 Super, during WWII (and maybe after).

Don Bady's book "Colt Automatic Pistols" mentions that sometime in 1940, the Ordnance Committee originated requirements for a selective fire version of the 1911A1 pistol. Have you seen anything to this effect?

Colt produced prototypes, probably about 4 to 6 pistols, based on Swartz's designs.

Serial numbers of known pistols are: GX7182, GX7184, C200695, and 17000. All of these have different features. GX7181, GX7183 and GX7185 may also be "select-fire".??

D.L.B., California



*A memo from Springfield Armory dated May 9, 1940, reported that Colt had developed an automatic pistol in .38 caliber, firing at the rate of 450 shots per minute; and that they intended to continue the development of such a .45 weapon, using a 20 shot magazine and having a select fire capability. One of these pistols, with long slide, was shown on the cover of our issue #64. I don't think they were developed in response to an Ordnance Dept. requirement; rather, as an entrant in the 1940 carbine trials and for other purposes.*

*Earlier, in August 1917, the Chief Signal Officer had requested that his office be furnished with five M1911 pistols altered to fire full automatically; this was in connection with a frame developed at Frankford Arsenal which allowed several pistols to be mounted in an airplane and fired simultaneously.*

S&W M1917 Packing

I'm looking for some documentation on the



boxes that the 1917 Smith & Wesson revolver was packed in from the factory, starting from serial number 1, Sept. 6, 1917, to about serial number 163,476, Nov. 1918.

Also, did the Government when they took over the plant on Sept. 16, 1918, make a change in the boxes?

*Good question. I know they were packed 50 to a wooden packing case, but I don't know how they were packaged inside the cases. I assumed that they were packed in a manner similar to rifles, i.e., unboxed and fitted into brackets within the packing case; but I don't know that to be true.*

*On Nov. 4, 1918, the National Operating Corp. raised the question of whether they could still mark the revolvers "Smith & Wesson", and I believe their marking was changed somewhat. If the revolvers were boxed, and if the S&W trademark appeared on the boxes, it was probably changed correspondingly.*

#### Custer Carbines

Sometime back I sort of got a bug in my head as to possibly coming up with some facts on the trapdoor carbines that were issued to the 7th Cav. before the Little Big Horn Battle, June 25, 1876.

I have come up with quite a bit of info. from various sources and quite a bit of open questions.

I do know that no records were kept by the National Armory as to where carbines were shipped by serial number. But the question I have been working on is if records of the serial numbers were kept at the various posts?

There is such a Table of Organization & Equipment in later years. This I have verified, but were those records kept in the 1870's by the various posts?

In all your research over the years and working at the National Archives have you ever ran across any record to that effect? I know there is records of the weekly work reports of NA, that Bud Waite found, and also a few that I found at the Springfield Armory Museum. In fact I found certain facts about the TD's in the Post Orders which were in the small library at the Museum. If these are still there I can't say, since the National Park Service took it over.

I want to show you several things that I ran across. In 1995 Butterfield & Butterfield had an auction on Custer items and of the period. One of the items was a cut down TD rifle SN 38553. I have picture or I should say copies of the pictures, that were in the catalog, even showing the serial number. Now according to records Capt. Benteen turned in carbine # 38553 classed as unserviceable in the 2nd quarter of 1877. How did a cut down rifle belong to the 7th? This is listed with 12 other carbines.

I have some copies of the carbines in the Rock Island Museum records that were sent to RIA from SA. A total of 5 guns. Now one of the guns is SN 124717. This gun was mfg'd. during the first quarter of 1880. If the SN is correct how could this gun be listed according to the RIA museum records, and quoted as stating it is in Ord. Note # 115, dated 10/1/1879.

I haven't looked into the Ord. Notes, Ch. of Ord. Reports or any other records for the trapdoor period in over 25 years. They were all available at the 42nd. St. Public Library in Manhattan, N.Y. I spent many many hours there.

Did you ever come across any records of SN's at Post Level?

Can you supply me, at a fee, a copy of Ord. Memo. # 115 covering # 101 thru 125, pages 152-174, or Report on Indian Arms in Annual Report of the Ch. of Ord. to the Sect. of War for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1879.

Footnote: I own a carbine SN 39010, which is 100% correct in every respect, but I know for a fact it could never have belonged to the 7th. Cav. The condition is too good to have ever seen hard service use, and it was never refinished. The wood is just too perfect, the ESA, P, and J.C. are as sharp as the day the gun came out of NA.

This SN is close to several guns turned in, 39448 and 39253. It came from the same batch from NA but never was shipped to the 7th. I would like to know where it was shipped to but I know this is an impossible question to answer.

*Sorry, we have nothing on carbine no. 39010. A copy of Ordinance Note 115 can be furnished at our usual rate of 30¢ per page; total \$7.20 ppd. You will find that serial no. 124717 is not listed.*

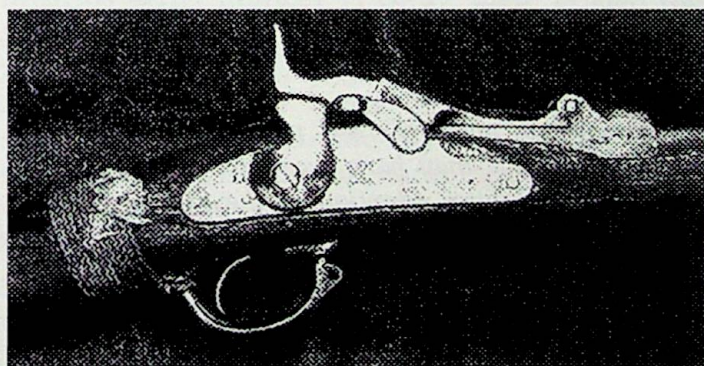
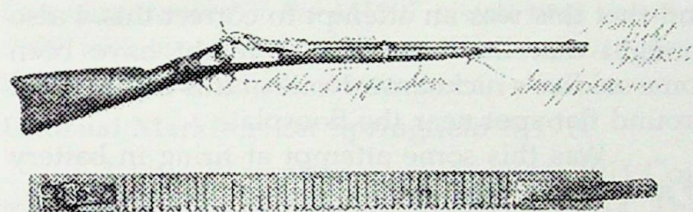


Likewise, we have carbine serial no. 38853 turned in by Benteen, but not 38553.

There was no such thing as a T.O. & E. during the Trapdoor era. Units simply submitted Orders for Supplies to the nearest arsenal, to requisition ordnance and ordnance supplies according to their needs. The number and kind of arms and equipment were then reported quarterly in Ordnance Returns. The later T.O. & E. did not list serial numbers, only the authorized level of each item.

I have gone through all the existing post records that promised to contain serial number data, finding some for other units but very little for the 7th Cavalry. We know that record of serial numbers were maintained in most units, but there are very few of these in the Archives.

### Mixed up in Action



I'm very sorry, it was my error in typing. As you can see, it is 38853 and not 38553.

It is listed by Benteen as carbine. No way; 100% cut down rifle. More than likely recovered from Indian.

B.D.E., Florida

It's a cut down rifle, all right. This is one of 10 carbines that were surveyed on Dec. 4, 1876 as a result of becoming unserviceable during the Battle of Little Big Horn.

Evidently, it was a battlefield pickup, a gun that was used by one of the Indians in the battle.

Its serial number, which is quite a bit higher than the

other carbines turned in by Benteen, indicates manufacture in 1875.

### Assembly vs. Manufacture of Trapdoors

Have been playing around with data on your serial number diskette, which I received September, 1996. This covered serial numbers through SRN #77 45/70 Trapdoor Springfields.

I have extracted the following information about the following serials:

The following questions are based on the assumption that a gun of a given serial number was "assembled", more or less, in serial number sequence.

Also, that a gun had to be assembled, before it could be manufactured.

So, in analyzing the above extracted data, we have an apparent situation where #8,627 was "manufactured" on a date much earlier than #54,978 (and several other much larger serials) was even "assembled".

And, further that #8,627 was "manufactured" before #104 was "assembled".

Similarly, #42,836 was "manufactured" before #54,978 was "assembled".

This raises some interesting questions, the answers to which are important to the student analyzing the apparent "creep" in reconciling the differences between extant serial numbers, number of guns "fabricated" per the Reports of the Chief of Ordnance, the dates found on the inspector's cartouche on the left side of the trapdoor stocks, and the standard Julian calendar. Now apparently we have some new "official" terminology (assembled & manufactured) to take into consideration. (I am assuming that your use of these words was based on their being used in the official



documents from which you obtained your data).

It would be nice if we could find a record of assembly and manufacture of the same serial number. But until that unlikely event occurs, we are forced to indulge in a bit of educated speculation, so:

Any comments you have on this situation would be appreciated.

When the term "assembled" is used in our listings, it refers to some process outside the regular course of manufacture. The weapons you cited were assembled at the San Antonio Arsenal (SAA) as a test of the armorer's ability to assemble cal. .45 rifles and carbines using various combinations of parts. One of these (no. 31601) is illustrated on pg. 1 of Serial Numbers of U.S. Martial Arms, Vol. 1.

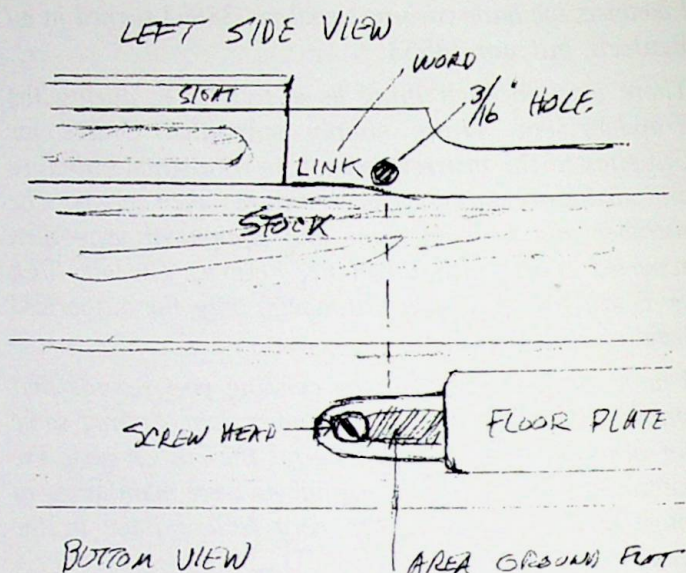
The term "manufactured" is probably synonymous in most cases with the term "packed", signifying the last step in the normal course of production in which the arms were packed into wooden crates before being turned over to the Ordnance Storekeeper ("turned into store"). The many records we have found of rifles originally packed into cases show a wide distribution of serial numbers within each case.

As you probably know, the annual reports were based on a fiscal year that ended on June 30 of the calendar year (e.g., fiscal year 1877 started on July 1, 1876). Thus many rifles tabulated as being fabricated in 1876, for example, were actually manufactured during the last six months of calendar year 1875.

### "Link" '03

I have a Springfield Armory Model 1903 rifle which I acquired from the DCM about 1947. The serial number is 1401643. The bolt handle is sloped slightly to the rear and it has a finger groove stock.

I have been curious about several things about this rifle since I received it. There is a 3/16" hole drilled through the left side of the front receiver ring and through the left side of the bolt. The holes line up when the bolt is closed. The word "Link" is scratched in the finish next to the hole. On the bottom of the rifle, the metal extension just forward of the floorplate is ground flat. This is exactly opposite the hole in the ring — see attached drawings. My first thought was that this



rifle might have had a habit of "punching" primers, and that this was an attempt to correct this. I also thought that the word "Link" might have been some soldier's nickname. None of this explains the ground flat spot near the floorplate.

Was this some attempt at firing in battery or something akin to the Pedersen device?

I also would like to know when it was manufactured. Thanks for any information you can give.

The receiver on your rifle was manufactured in 1931, although the rifle may have been assembled sometime later. This was after adoption of the "C" stock with corresponding M1903A1 designation; however, Springfield continued to assemble the type "S" finger-groove stock to service rifles in order to use up stocks on hand. Gas escape holes were drilled in many receivers still in service starting in 1936; a matching hole was added to or enlarged in the bolt.

I don't know the significance of the word "Link" or the flat spot on the trigger guard tang.

### Early .45 ACP Ammo

In the NRA magazine they did a story of the Colt .45 auto Model 1907.

I have a box of Winchester orange label 200 gr. blt's 50 rd box.

On the side of this lift off box is marked US PROPERTY.

I believe that this commercial box was sold



to the Army for testing their 200 1907s. Am I right, and how many rounds of ammo was purchased by the government? And was all the ammo used up or destroyed?

*The ammunition used in initial testing of the M1907 pistols was furnished by Colt. Possibly it was manufactured by Winchester, but I have no information on this.*

*The 10th Cavalry reported at the end of some test periods that a substantial quantity of ammunition had not been used up. I have seen nothing on disposal or destruction of this ammunition, but no doubt some of it managed to get "liberated" from the service.*

*The earliest .45 ACP cartridges had a narrow extractor groove; the groove was widened to its present form in 1909. The width of the groove on the cartridges in your box, if any, might give a clue to its date of manufacture. Of course, testing of the M1907 pistols went on after 1909, with the extractors being modified to better adapt them to the wide-groove ammo.*

#### **Unusual Markings on Springfield M1911**

I am contemplating purchasing a 1911 Colt manufactured at Springfield Armory in 1914. The firearms serial number is 80017 there is also the number C 176927 stamped on the front of the receiver, below the trigger guard; and with the slide closed, on the barrel the letters "H.P." are stamped. Can you provide any information about this firearm? What do the stampings mean?

Also with the pistol are a number of clips. Four of these had the letters "A", "B", or "L" stamped on the tab on the clip base. Can you tell me what they mean or signify?

*We have some numbers very close to this one, but not 80017. "C 176927" seems to be in the commercial M1911 series, but I can't imagine how it would come to be struck on a Springfield Armory product.*

*Likewise, I don't know the meanings of the other marks. The barrel lug should have a P stamped on the side if it is a military barrel; if this mark is absent, then I would assume that "H.P." stands for a commercial maker.*

*Hopefully, one of our M1911 experts will have a better answer for you.*

#### **Serial Numbers on Springfield M1863 Musket**

I have a 1863 Springfield Musket Type II. There are three serial numbers that I can make out. Do you know any solution, fluid or chemical that will bring the others clear. How many serial numbers are there in this type musket?

*Springfield Armory didn't mark any muskets before the Model 1868 with serial numbers. Are you possibly mistaking cartouches (inspector marks) in the stock for serial numbers? If there are numbers in the metal, they were placed there by a dealer or owner after your gun left the service.*

*I don't know any good way to bring out markings other than a thorough cleaning, and even that can do more harm than good.*

#### **Inspector J.F.E. Chamberlain**

I have recently obtained a Smith & Wesson Number 2 Army with the following inscription on the sideplate: "PRESENTED TO J.F.E. CHAMBERLAIN BY HIS FRIENDS AT THE U.S. ARMORY". No date is mentioned, but I have contacted Smith & Wesson and found that the gun was shipped to a local Springfield dealer in September of 1862.

Enclosed is what little I know of J.F.E. Chamberlain. If you can provide any additional information on the man such as a biographical or employment record, I would be very happy.

*I don't have any references to J.F.E. Chamberlain. I have a lot of data on personnel of the Springfield Armory Inspection Service, particularly during the Civil War; Chamberlain's absence from these listings leads me to believe that the occasion for the presentation of this pistol was his departure for service in the Union army.*

*The payroll records are our best source for information on the service of Springfield workmen.*

*Too bad it wasn't presented to J.L. (Joshua Lawrence) Chamberlain!*

#### **Henry Nettleton, Trapdoor Inspector**

I have a M-1873 Carbine in my collection that was manufactured in the last quarter of 1880, ser # 144075.

The gun appears to be correct in every respect. I have a question about the breech-block. It has the filled-in arch which is correct and does



not appear to be a replacement. It is dark blue in color which appears to be Arsenal applied. The bottom flat of the breech-block has the letters H.N. stamped in the center near the end of the flat. This apparent sub-inspections mark is identical to those on my Henry Nettleton inspected SAA.

Can the dark blue color be correct for a post 1878 type breech-block?

Did Henry Nettleton inspect and mark M1873 Carbine parts? I have never encountered such marks on other M1873 rifles or carbines.

Incidentally, this gun is in very fine condition retaining over 60% original finish and is SWP/1882 inspected.

S.E.B, Georgia

*I believe your breech block is the original one installed on this carbine.*

*I have some notes from the SA payroll records that show Henry Nettleton working on condemned components, cal. .45, in January, 1882. I think this was in connection with the "starred" rifles and carbines that were made up about that time; but it is possible that some of the previously-condemned components inspected by HN were marked by him, finished up, and installed in non-starred arms.*

#### U.S. Martial Arms in Canadian Service c. 1942

You may already have this on file, but pgs. 60/61 give not only a good thumbnail lesson in Short Magazine Lee Enfield (SMLE) identification, but "what every Canadian should know" about the lend-lease American rifles. Note that No. 11 deals with (Model 1894) Winchesters; we also received a number of Marlins, both in .30-30.

Photographs of the local Coastal Artillery Fire Command Posts show P-17's - with their red bands - neatly racked; and this manual was issued to a local Coastal Artillery unit.

I have yet to encounter specific serial number listings for lend-lease arms in local archives; I'll certainly forward any that I find.

sion. We took it out to the range to fire it, inserted the .50-70 cartridge in the chamber, and it went through the barrel and out the muzzle. I guess assumptions are dangerous. We then took the rifle home and made a chamber casting, and it turned out to be chambered to .58 Berdan. I can find no reference to a military conversion to .58 Berdan in any of the standard references on Sharps or military rifles. As the rifle is as new, and has the standard military conversion cartouches, I have to assume it was done by the military. Does anybody have anything on this or can point me in the right direction? Has anyone else ever seen one of these in .58 Berdan?

Sellers mentions some conversions to .56 rimfire in his book on the Sharps, and we recently found a report in the Navy Bureau of Ordnance records about a test of a metallic cartridge "Patent of 1859" Sharps rifle on July 20, 1861. This rifle was described as having a 0.5635" bore and barrel length of 32.80". I have seen nothing in the Ordnance records about conversions to anything but .50 caliber.

### **VMI Cadet Muskets**

Henry M. Stewart, Jr., before his death in 1989, wrote a very informative article on the VMI Springfield M1851 Cadet Musket. The article was in the PAGCA newsletter of April 1988, No. 222.

*It's a very interesting article but leaves open the question of why they used Austrian muskets at New Market. Cadet muskets at that time were not merely ornamental, they were used in target practice and field exercises by the cadets.*

*It seems unlikely that they would have loaned their cadet muskets to regular CSA troops, as stated in the American Rifleman article, and then gotten them back sometime before 1864.*

*Another thing I don't understand is why the bayonet is numbered, but not the musket.*

*The 1851 Cadet musket I have is dated 1853 on lock-plate and breech plug; unlike Henry Stewart's musket, it is rifled and has the long range sight. The top of the lower band is numbered "244", but the bayonet has no numbers. This bayonet is rather strange in that it has moderate pitting on the socket and clasp, but no serious sign of rust on the blade (possibly a result of having been protected by the scabbard). But of course the '51 Cadet bayonet is very scarce in any condition, so I am glad to have it, pits and all.*

*Another article, by Keith E. Gibson and George E. Whitling (curator of the VMI Museum), which appeared in the Sept/Oct 1995 issue of North-South Trader Civil War magazine, was submitted by Dick Marsden. This article states that the VMI Cadet muskets were in fact loaned to a CSA unit (the Rockbridge Grays) in 1861 and later returned. The reason they were not used in the New Market action is apparently that they were lightly constructed smoothbore arms, without rear sights, and in a non-standard caliber (0.57). There is no mention of the caliber of the Lorenz rifle muskets used by the VMI Cadets at New Market,*

*but evidently there was no shortage of suitable ammunition for them.*

*The NSTCW article makes clear that neither the VMI Cadet Muskets nor their bayonets were numbered, despite the fact that a numbered bayonet was illustrated in the PAGCA article. All of these muskets were dated "1851", and all 1851-dated Cadet muskets were issued to VMI, so they are easy to recognize. However, only about a dozen have come to light, and most of those are relics recovered from the Maury River, where the VMI ordnance barges were sunk in 1864.*

*The following letter adds more to the story of these historic weapons.*

Regarding the VMI M1851 Cadet Muskets, there is a return for the years 1851-58 of ordnance and ordnance stores at the Lexington, Virginia arsenal located at the Virginia Military Institute. There is an entry for September 16, 1851 of 200 Muskets, Percussion, Bright received from Gen. Richardson (State Adj. General). These are believed to be the 200 M1851 Cadet Muskets, since no other similar item appears during the time covered by the report. It is my understanding that there is an entry from the Springfield Armory record which shows the shipment of the arms to Virginia.

From this return, it appears that these were held in store until July 1858, when 118 were issued to the Corps of Cadets. The same entry listed issuance of 118 each of cap pouches, cartridge boxes, bayonet scabbards, and waist belts and plates.

Also listed are 22 swords from previous returns which were issued to the Corps at this time. These are probably the remaining Ames cadet swords from the 40 originally procured by Virginia 1840-47.

### **2nd U.S. Volunteer Engineer Trapdoor**

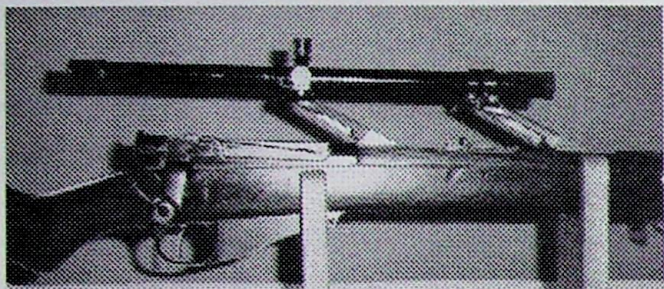
There is one item of interest in #79 from the Guns "Lettered" section. I refer to the M1884 Rifle issued to Co. A, 2nd. US Volunteer Engineer Regiment. Just last week I obtained two photographs of Co. B of the 2nd. One shows the entire company including an individual wearing the stripes of a sergeant major. He is armed with a M1840 non-com's sword and a revolver. Officers are armed with the M1860 Staff & Field Officer's Sword. The troops are armed with the .45-70 Rifle. Those that



can be distinguished appear to be late Model 1873's because they have the M1879 buckhorn rear sights. It would seem that not all volunteer troops received M1884's, as many of us believed. Here is photographic evidence that this was not the case.

### 'Scope Sighted Winchester-Lee Rifle



I've enclosed some photos of a Winchester-Lee I've acquired recently.

The rifle is unmarked except for the traditional Winchester proof mark on the receiver ring, along with the serial number 14402.

The only information I've been able to come up with so far, is that Winchester shows the gun was modified in Feb., 1912. The scope is marked only with "Winchester Trade Mark" Patent Pending. The scope is 15¾" long with conventional crosshairs.

The scope mounts are brass, hand stamped WINCHESTER on each. The mounts off-set the scope to the left and they are machined so the shooter can see through them and use the iron sights.

I'm assuming that any information on guns like this, that might have been submitted for Government tests, would have gone to the Archives.

*Sorry, we have no information on Winchester-Lee rifles in this serial range, and nothing on Government procurement or usage of these rifles with telescopic sights. If the 'scope was installed in 1912, it would have been too late for the Navy or Army ordnance to have any interest in this rifle or the 6mm cartridge.*

### 24" Model 1884 Carbine

Please advise me as to the cost of tracing a U.S. military firearm. The rifle is a Springfield Trapdoor .45-70 carbine with SN 402943. The rifle

has a 24" barrel. From a table in an old Dixie Gun Works catalog, 5003 carbines were made in 1888 with SN's between 387,596 and 426,723. Of these, three were reported as having a 24" barrel.

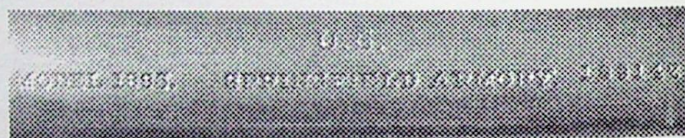
I am particularly interested to know if SN 402943 was originally a carbine. Did it originally have a 24" barrel, or was this gun assembled from parts?

*We don't have anything on this serial number, which would place it in late 1887 or early 1888 production. The Model 1886 Experimental Carbines were completed in fiscal 1886 at about serial number 340xxx. The Springfield Armory production reports show that one 24" carbine was completed in fiscal 1888, but I don't have it's number. Two more were made in fiscal 1889.*

*The 24" carbines made by Springfield in 1886 can be distinguished by unique stocks, differently calibrated and marked rear sights, and a ring at the muzzle.*

### Model 1896/1898 Serial Number Overlap



Enclosed is a close up photograph taken with serial # 109142. This rifle is a Model 1896 with a 1896 stock, cartouched 1898, The rear sight has been updated to a 1901 along with a 1901 hand guard. The front sight is a 1901/02 style and the upper barrel band is a 1898 (split) style.

Per our conversation, I would guess this gun to be the very end of production. In your records, you show a 1898 rifle with serial number 109125. I don't know where this gun may have been in Springfield system but I would guess it to be one of the last 1896 rifles made?

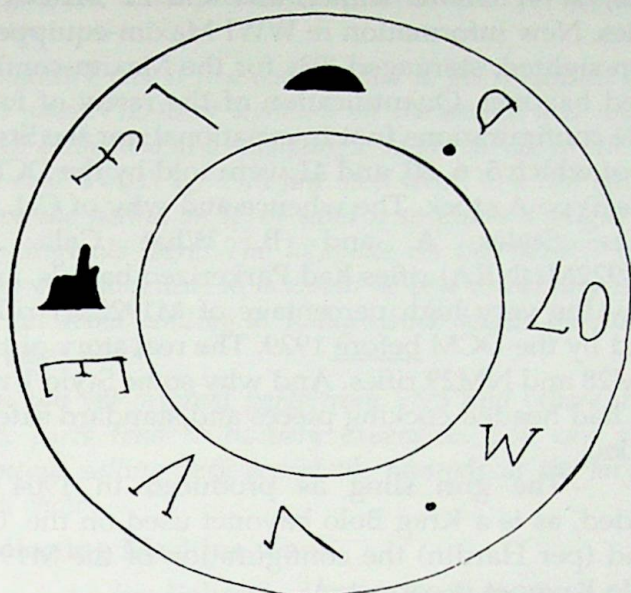
*Sounds like one of the last of the Model 1896 rifles, all right. Let's see if any of the readers has seen a higher numbered M1896.*

### M1863 Springfield Rifle Musket Markings

I have recently acquired a U.S. Springfield 1863 Rifled Musket. The firearm is in good condition with a number of "hack" marks on the front portion of the barrel from bayonet strikes. While this battle damage may preclude this weapon from ever becoming a Museum showpiece, I am all the



more intrigued in finding its history.



Upon disassembly and cleaning, I've noted the following:

"U.S. SPRINGFIELD", an Eagle and "1863" located on the face of the lockplate;

An Eagle located below the cap nipple on the barrel;

"TVF" located on back of lockplate as viewed with only the barrel removed;

"O" or "C" located on back of lockplate as viewed with barrel removed;

"US" located on upper tang of buttplate;

"V" and "2" located on inside of trigger guard;

"A" located on front tang of the trigger plate;

"VP" and an Eagle's head and a dot located to one side of the back of the barrel;

"1863" located on the top of the barrel;

"T" and a Star and possibly a "U" located on the barrel breech screw;

"U" located on the first and third barrel bands;

"1" located inside the third barrel band.

I have enclosed a sketch of the back of the barrel with the breech screw removed.

*This is of interest because the breech end markings appear to include the eagle's head proof mark. I thought this might explain why we sometimes see it on the rear barrel flat of the M1866 BLRM, and other times not. However, it appears that this '63 musket also has the eagle's head in that position.*

### The '03 Era Review

I much appreciate your having included a review of my new book, The '03 Era, in the last issue of U.S. Martial Arms Collector, and am gratified that Wayne Gagner pronounced that it is "definitely" a "worthwhile" purchase to replace currently held copies of The '03 Springfields.

I must submit, however, that I think Mr. Gagner, while properly citing the authoritative new chapter on WWII USMC sniper rifles, was wide of the mark in citing chapters re ammunition and "commercial sporters" (??) rather than the chapters re rifles, accessories, and appendages, which are those of interest to arms collectors and which even a rather cursory comparison will reveal to contain much that is added and much that is new:

Additions include, of course, the Air Service, WWI USMC sniper, and Cal..22 M2(NRA) rifles. New information re WWI Maxim-equipped, iron sighted, stargaged '03s for the Maxim-configured bayonet. Quantification of the rarity of four rifle configurations (not International nor the Style T) of which 5, 6, 30, and 41 were sold by the DCM. The Type A stock. The whence and why of Cal..30 rifles Styles A and B. What Cal. .22 M1922M1(NRA) rifles had Parkerized barrels, and why the very high percentage of M1922M1 rifles sold by the DCM before 1929. The real story of the NM28 and NM29 rifles. And why some Style T rifles had headed cocking pieces and standard safety locks.

The gun sling as produced in 1904 is added, as is a Krag Bolo bayonet used on the '03. And (per Hardin) the configuration of the M1909 Bolo bayonet is corrected.

When many hundreds or even thousands of dollars ride on a deal, any increased knowledge that a few dollars can buy may well be critical!

### Cleaning Up Musket

A friend just gave me (you read that right!) a Springfield CW rifle.

It appears to be a U.S. Model 1863. The barrel is a little bigger than .58, however. It has the right lock plate including the simplified bolster for percussion, has the larger redesigned hammer, but does not have the modified barrel bands with screws. The ram rod is missing, as is the sling attachment on the trigger guard.

Can you recommend a book on Springfields? I really only collect revolvers. It's pretty rusty, but the wood is in fine shape (no cracks), and there are two cartouches on the left side. Should I consider having it professionally cleaned? Are old original parts available somewhere, or should I settle for repros from Dixie Gun Works?

*Try to get Robert M. Reilly's United States Military Small Arms 1816-1865. It sounds like you have the*



M1863 Type II, which has solid bands. If the barrel has no grooves, it has probably been drilled out for use as a shotgun.

I wouldn't give it to a restorer just to get it cleaned up. Put some WD40 or light oil on the barrel, and use a razor blade held at a small angle to the barrel, to cut off the rust. Finish up with fine steel wool. You can either leave the patina on it, or sand it to finish it bright as the originals were. The lockplate on the M1863 was color casehardened, so it would be best to cut any rust off but avoid sanding it. Reilly's book details the finish on other parts.

You can get original parts from S&S and others, but lock parts tend to be very expensive. You can find someone selling very acceptable ramrods at the larger gun shows.

### Collecting Machine Guns

Lt. Jim Ballou is doing a book on the B.A.R. from its inception. I noticed that you'd found some MG serial #s in your research. Jim might be interested in B.A.R. #s & info.

Readers of *Machine Gun News* could well be interested in the S/N info. Lotta richniks into collectable MGs now.

I am far from rich but I do have a few MGs. The most collectable is a Benet Mercie M1909 by Springfield Armory #197. If this one shows up, please let me know (especially in clutches of troops in Columbus, N.M.). Also have USN marked Savage .303 Lewis s/n 204331.

Might be more interest in MG serial numbers than appears!

Trying to separate the numbers for Civil War carbines and revolvers is bad enough; now you want me to take on machine guns? How many firms made Lewis machine guns, for example, and was there a single serial number sequence?

I offered to give away a copy of the High Standard machine gun delivery records, but there has been no taker. Also, I can write letters on delivery of H&R Reising subs. That's about the best I can do for MGs.

### Navy Rolling Block .22

I'm trying to determine if a rolling block I purchased recently might be one of Navy's 0.22 conversions. The rifle is a Springfield Armory

manufactured rolling block. It is marked on the right side "U.S. Navy" and has an eagle with wings spread. There is a faint ESA cartouche in an oval on the left side of the stock just behind the metal. The tang has the usual Remington patents. There are no inspector's marks and the rear sight groove is half inch from the receiver ring. All this is typical of a rifle sold to France during the Franco Prussian war.

The unusual things about the rifle are as follows. On the left side of the barrel just in front of the receiver ring is the following stamping: "No. 7 WWK 1889". The breechblock has been threaded on its face and a penny sized steel disk screwed into place. The firing pin has been replaced with a sleeve with an offset firing pin that goes thru a hole in the bottom of the metal disk. The rear sight has had the ladder removed and only retains the battlefield sight. The extractor is missing, and the barrel is in the 50/70 caliber configuration.

I'm trying to determine if this is one of the rolling blocks converted by the U.S. Navy to fire 0.22 in 1889. Evidence for this is the breechblock conversion and the barrel stamping. Against this the lack of inspectors marks suggesting the rifle was never in U.S. service, no barrel insert in 0.22, and a statement in Flaydermann that the serial numbers were always two digits suggesting that it should read "07" not "7".

Any help you might offer would be appreciated.

I don't know whether the single-digit numbers were preceded by a 0. We have only four numbers for these, all 2-digit. I have seen extensive documentation on these in the Navy Bureau of Ordnance records, but I don't think it went into the serial number striking.

### Colt "Alaskan" Revolver

I recently purchased a Colt Model 1878---1902 "Alaskan". The pistol is in very nice condition; the SN is 47877. Can you furnish me with any information about this gun? I am a member of the Colt Collector's Assn. and will ask Colt for a letter but I was hoping you could go into greater depth--I'm more than happy to pay any research fees.

Also, I am toying about doing a short article on these pistols for the Texas Gun Collectors magazine. Could you point me in the right direc-



tion regarding original contracts, dates, reason for larger trigger guard, etc.?

*It would cost about \$60 to furnish a copy of the documentation on development and procurement of these revolvers. The trigger was made longer to give better leverage for the stronger mainspring that was found necessary to ensure ignition with ammunition designed for use with the SAA. It was thought that the smaller Filipinos might want to use two fingers to pull the trigger in double-action shooting. That's all there was to it.*

#### '03 No. 1516543

A third request - another model 1903 Springfield, serial # 1516543 — it appears to be a heavy barrel target.

I am desperately fearful of the future of our hobby. The faking has reached the epidemic stage. The fakers are beginning to refine their techniques and some of it is getting so good that it is difficult to detect. This week alone, I was authenticating a revolver which I had authenticated back in 1992. Many of the faults which I had pointed out then, had now been "corrected".. Boy, am I glad I had the old records! I don't know about the other U.S. Martial firearms, but if it is anywhere as bad as it is with the U.S. Colts, then we had all better team together to try to stop these practices..

*We have had this problem with U.S. military arms for years — nobody knows how many early '03s have been 'reconverted' from knife bayonet to rod bayonet. Then we have the put-together reweld M1s, 'bolo bayonets' that were never such, etc. Some collectors who should know better have "created" rare models because they dispaired of ever finding an affordable original. In at least one case, somebody asked me to authenticate a weapon (.50 cal. Trapdoor pistol) that was recognized by one of our readers as having been created by him years ago. He was amazed that anyone would accept it as an original; but this can be expected to happen with the passage of sufficient time.*

*On the other hand, there is a lot of restoration going on that seems to me to be justified. For example, who can blame the owner of a M1896 carbine for wanting to have the correct rear sight on his piece (if only one could be found)? And while you might disagree, I think it would be justifiable for a collector to replace civilian grips or hammer that somebody had installed on a Cavalry Colt, with original-type parts.*

*But restoration can be carried too far. As you know, there are people who are refinishing these guns and even applying inspection stamps that are indistinguishable from the originals. I think that the emphasis on condition has lessened as a result of the work of authors such as yourself. ☹*

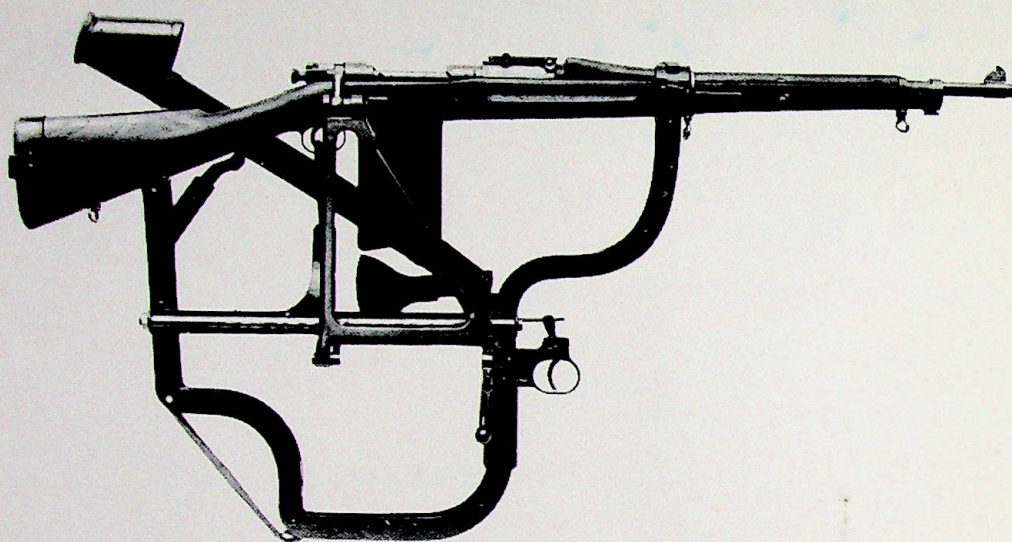
