Miscellaneous News and Notes

HOPEFULLY, the destruction of Krag rifles and other collectible U. S. martial arms in Government hands has been stopped, as mentioned in issue 61. Unfortunately, this comes many years too late to prevent the destruction of two very significant developmental arms, the cal. .22 Krag rifles nos. 148252 and 279343 adapted to Hoffer-Thompson cartridge holders. These were reported destroyed at New Cumberland General Reserve Depot in 1929, along with 14 other cal. .22 and 731 cal. .30 Krag (15 of which are listed in our data base).

We received a copy of Bruce Canfield's latest book, *A Collector's Guide to United States Combat Shotguns*, while issue 61 was being printed. This is another fine effort on Bruce's part, showing extensive use of Ordnance documentation combined with careful examination of specimens, and with a lot of interesting anecdotes to keep it lively. In common with other books in his *Collector's Guide* series, it lacks a proper index to its 184 pages. But the book is very well organized, and the detailed "Subjective Index and Table of Contents" is a pretty good substitute. Illustrations are numerous and excellent. Autographed copies (softcovers only) are available from the author at PO Box 892, Shreveport, LA 71162; price \$24 plus \$4 shipping. There seems to be a lot of interest in military shotguns, and I am sure this volume will be well received.

Fresh off the press is C. S. "Nick" Ferris' book, *The Rock Island '03*. Nick does an excellent job of unraveling the mysteries of early rifle production as well as covering all other aspects of rifle and bayonet manufacture at RIA. Illustrations are generally outstanding, and they include many photos of Arsenal shops, as well as of markings on wood and metal. '03 collectors won't want to be without this. Autographed copies are available from C.S. Ferris, Box 420, Arvada CO 80001; price, \$12.50 plus \$1.50 shipping.

Our research at Suitland during this period has mainly concerned the 1915-31 records of the Chief of Ordnance, and we have turned up some interesting facts on the development of the 1911A1 pistol and the M1903 Cavalry Carbine, as well as a large volume of serial number data.

At the main Archives, I have been trying to find some information on the Model 1858 Cadet bayonet (a rare item, as it turns out). In going through the Ordnance Dept. letters received for the 1856-58 period, I have found a lot of information on musket conversions, procurement of Colt percussion revolvers and other pistols, and development and production of the Model 1855 series of arms. Notes on these will appear in a future issue.

Serial number records for the .380 and .32 General Officer's Pistols has been requested, but the copies have not yet been received. §

Are you interested in being notified of serial numbers that don't appear in the 3 volumes of listings?

Recently I observed an 1873 carbine in the Buffalo Bill Museum in the firearms section. The serial # is 46234. Apparently the rifle at one time was in the hands of Indians, as it has brass tacks in the stock and is in rather rough condition; but it is apparently correct. The front band is plain, no provision for swivel, front sight pinned blade type, plain trigger bow, second type hammer, smooth trigger.

The firearms display at the museum in Cody, Wyoming is a fantastic display. I really enjoy going there.

We discuss many guns by serial number here, but they won't be published in our serial number book series unless we have official documentation on them. The only exception is for guns in museum collections that are accessible to the public. The Buffalo Bill Museum qualifies.

We have no information on no. 46234; in fact, no data on other Model 1873 Carbines in this serial range.

My particular interest is in the .45/70 1873 Springfield rifles; carbines in particular. I have enclosed a stamped & self address envelope in hopes you can tell me if prospects look good for obtaining many more serial numbers on the early carbines?

I have a receiver serial #20164 which is three numbers away from 10th Cav carbine #20161. Maybe more numbers in the future could verify its original unit assignment.

Do you personally feel that in the future the serial numbers of the carbines of the 7th Cav will be revealed or uncovered in your research?

We are still pursuing the numbers of Indian Wars period weapons, and I expect that we will find small blocks of these from time to time; however, it is very difficult to predict. I am presently going through more records of Western forts; also, actively trying to find old records at RIA. I don't think we will find all the carbine numbers for Custer's command, but I hope to

find the numbers of the 200 or so that were sent to RIA for analysis after the battle.

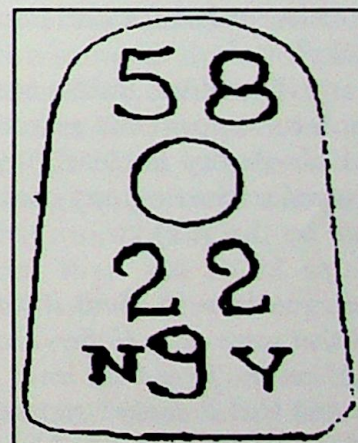
A Model 1884 carbine in the collection, SN 448081, has "S.P.F. C23" branded in a single line parallel to the left side of the buttstock's comb, at the heel.

G.D.M., Colorado

Thanks for the info. I recently came across some additional correspondence from the Penna. Dept. of State Police: 1) letter dated Apr. 18, 1917, requesting permission to purchase 330 "Crag-Jordensen" carbines to replace and augment the 250 Springfield .45 carbines purchased in 1905; 2) letter dated July 7, 1917, requesting permission to purchase 350 "Springfield Rifles, caliber .45"; and 3) letter dated May 12, 1921, expressing a desire to purchase 25 "Colt .38 caliber service revolvers, Model 1903".

The request to purchase Krag's was evidently turned down, because a law had been passed on the eve of WWI banning the sale of all serviceable weapons (not including trapdoors).

I have a Model 1903 Springfield, serial # 45331 which was altered from the rod bayonet configuration to take the M1905 bayonet and altered again to take the M1906 cartridge. While none of this is in any way unique, the butt tang tag is of interest.



It carries the following markings: "58", "22", and "N 9 Y". I have had the rifle for more than 40 years. The stock, which was originally cut for the rod bayonet, is marked with an ILA 1904 cartouche. The stock tip is marked "s". The barrel is marked "S A - Bomb 05".

The fact that this piece was apparently issued to the New York National Guard probably accounts for its survival in its initial altered

condition.

I realize that this is not sufficient evidence to add to the serial number references, (but) the information may be of interest to the collecting fraternity.

We have some serial number data for four different regiments of the New York National Guard, but none for the 9th or 229th. The inspector cartouche is probably "JSA" rather than "ILA".

Regarding Mr. Ferris' comments about the "S" marking on the tip of '03 stocks, I believe he is incorrect. I have a Springfield M1903 rifle in my collection in 1905 configuration still chambered for the original .30-03 cartridge. The stock has what is unquestionably an authentic "S" marking on the forend tip. Since the stock has not been altered and remains in its original longer .30-03 length, this would appear to definitely refute Mr. Ferris' theory about the shortened and/or spitzer bullet business. While others may have observed such "S" markings on rod bayonet stocks altered to .30-06 length, I do not recall ever seeing any. Such stocks would be expected to have this marking if one subscribes to Mr. Ferris' theory. In addition, if the "S" does not denote Springfield, what does the "RIA" stand for on later issue Rock Island '03 stocks?

Therefore, unless Mr. Ferris has documentation to support his assertions, it would appear that his theory is clearly incorrect. I would look forward to hearing any comments which you may have on the subject.

B.N.C., Louisiana

Well, you have to admit it's a pretty neat theory; the fact that some early Hoffer-Thompson rifles are marked ".22" on the forend tip lends some support to it. But it seems that it doesn't stand up to serious scrutiny. I had overlooked the stocks I have observed with "RI" on the forend tip. Also, it would seem that if this was a standard practice, I would have seen something on it in the tons of Ordnance documentation I have gone through. Perhaps Nick has some documentation?

B.N.C. has objected that the S (or s) on the fore-end tip of '03 rifle stocks cannot mean "shortened" for using model 1906 ammunition, be-

cause he has an early Springfield still configured for model 1903 ammunition and having a stock with an S (s?) on the end. This sort of empirical evidence is welcome and necessary to our developing a body of data about uncertain details. My few observations are to the contrary: lacking an official Ordnance Dept. explanation, we certainly need more observations. The theory that the S or s means shortened is only one of several ideas held by collectors, but I liked it because it was practical (warning against using the wrong ammunition). One other idea is that it stands for Springfield, as in made there. This is wrong as far as Rock Island rifles with capital S on their fore-ends are concerned. The story goes that R.I.A. could not make stocks, so it got all its stocks from Springfield and marked them with the S. (Springfield, meanwhile, used a small s). R.I.A. did indeed get 5,000 stocks initially, but it otherwise made its own stocks from 1904 thru 1913. Documentary evidence includes materials purchased (Chief of Ordnance reports), bid requests from the Commanding Officer, R.I.A. to interested suppliers, and a photograph of stocks being made at R.I.A. in 1905).

Of importance to collectors is that the typical Rock Island stock made thru 1913 has a script CN cartouche and an S (not s) on the fore-end. CN was the R.I.A. final inspector, Conrad Nelson, and the S is correct for Rock Island, whatever it means. It can hardly mean Springfield, given the very many thousands of stocks made by R.I.A.; but of course, collectors have not generally known about CN or the stocks. Furthermore, RI on some stocks made the S a natural for Springfield. However, the RI is on World War One R.I.A. stocks, and not those of the 1904-1913 period of manufacture.

In re-reading B.N.C.'s comments just before mailing this off to you, I see that I have missed a point. This is not meant to refute him, but I own a Springfield stock that was shortened from rod bayonet configuration to that for the .30-'06 and it has a small s right in the wooden plug on the fore-end. But as far as the theory about "shortened" goes, it is not restricted to stocks that themselves were shortened; it would also include subsequent stocks that were made shorter in the

first place. To carry this as far as 1913 seems so unnecessary as to weaken the theory, but it is interesting that Springfield did not continue the S mark as long as Rock Island did. That suggests that its need was temporary as one would suppose if the theory were correct.

B.N.C. refers to "my" assertions and theory. It is really a suggestion, and it isn't actually mine. Rather, it is one of several ideas collected over time from various students of the '03, and the one that appealed most to me.

It is too bad we don't have documentation for everything, but we don't. Suggestions, speculation, and deduction are indeed warranted in that event as long as they are identified as such, simply because they will get people to thinking and comparing data. Otherwise, we'll just fall asleep waiting for documentation on the damn S and other such uncertainties. And we will determine what we know, think we know, and don't know. Your column is well suited to this purpose.

Frank, I'm glad to know about B.N.C.'s rifle, even if the marks don't support a neat idea. The one 1905 (i.e. .30-'03) R.I.A. gun I've seen has no S (or s). Nor do the 1905 S.A.s, but they are very few. Perhaps thru your column. we can get more data.

I can only conclude that the meaning of the "S" mark is still not definitely known. Re the continuation of this practice beyond the early years, I suggest that this would indicate that if it does stand for "short" or "shortened", this might indicate that the mark was applied to stocks in the manufacturing store, rather than completed rifles. The fact that this mark is not mentioned in any edition of the Description and Rules for the Management of the '03 rifle implies that it is not something that shooters were to be concerned with; thus, if it does stand for "short", it would be analogous to the "H" for "hardened" that was stamped in bayonet lugs. Springfield in particular built up quite a large stockpile of stocks, to the point that they overflowed available storage space and ultimately created somewhat of a scandal.

Hopefully, we will hear from other '03 collectors on this. A couple of our subscribers specialize in the collection of '03 stocks (with or without attached metal parts) having different markings.

Thank you for your response in the Martial Arms Collector and Springfield Research Newsletter No. 61, to my dissertation on the M1922 family of rifles. I can always find room in my collection, it seems, for another NRA M1922 or cal. 30 sporter. M1922 M1 rifle serial number 20252 represents an intriguing coincidence, with respect to two other collection M1922 M1s. I have two rifles that are just 28 serial numbers apart, 20196 with original sale in 1932, and 20224 which was sold in 1931. My latest acquisition turns out to be exactly 28 serial numbers above 20224. All three rifles are drilled and tapped for scope mounts on the barrel and receiver, and the barrels are dated 10-31. Also note that this latest rifle is just 4 numbers below your M1922 M1, serial number 20256, which you mentioned in the newsletter. My rifle is listed as sold in 1932, which also tracks with likely manufacturing dates and the sale dates for rifles numbers 20196 and 20224. I wonder what Springfield Armory did with your rifle between 1931 and 1940, when it was sold to Western Cartridge Company?

I thought you might be interested in the identification of another Cal. 22 M2 NRA Model rifle. I recently acquired M2 NRA Model Rifle, serial number 5833, with a barrel date of 7-37. This rifle is parkerized, and drilled and tapped for scope mounts, exactly the same as my other M2 NRA Model, serial number 5588, which also has a barrel date of 7-37. Number 5833 is not listed in your Summary of DCM Rifle Sales, but the number is certainly within a range up to serial number 6561. It would appear that more M2 NRA cal. .22 rifles were manufactured than are DCM sales listed, but I guess we will never know for sure just how many.

My theory concerning M1922M1 rifle serial no. 20256 is that it was issued or loaned to WCC soon after manufacture in 1931 or early 1932, then finally purchased by them in 1940. This is the only way to explain why it escaped conversion to M2 bolt.

The only production figure I have found to date on M2 NRA rifles is 50 made in Fiscal Year 1936. Judging from the barrel dates on yours, more were made later.

I own an unusual M1903 Springfield

Heavy Barrel target rifle that may be of interest to you or your readers:

1. The receiver is numbered 1516604. It is blue with polished rails, etc. exactly like a style "T". It has the large gas hole though. The underside is marked "P J 101".

2. The bolt is polished, marked "N S" above the handle and a small crescent is milled from the handle for scope clearance. The underside is etched "USE ONLY ON 1516604". It has a headless cocking piece and a reverse safety.

3. The 28" barrel has a star gauge number (SA 504) about 8" from the breech on the bottom. It has Style "T" dimensions (1.4" at breech) except it is less tapered forward of the band. The outside diameter at the muzzle is 1.1". The crown is flat and shows concentric circular machine marks. "Factory type" scope blocks are attached 7.2" apart with the rear block placed immediately ahead of the receiver ring. The muzzle is not machined for the Browning front sight but is tapped for a block accepting a Lyman 77 globe sight.

4. The stock is an exact Style "T" in all respects except it has part number SA 6597 stamped 1/2" forward of the rear swivel. There is no circle P proof on the pistol grip.

This certainly looks like a Springfield Armory assembly to me. Can you shed any light on it?

I have had a similar Style "T" rifle for about forty years; serial no. 1516614. It has a 30-in. barrel, and I believe the barrel on yours was the same length originally. It has the same "PJ 101" marking on the receiver bottom, but with stargauge mark "SA E-27" on the bottom of the barrel. Mine unfortunately has a replacement bolt; the stock bears the same part no. as yours, and the sight blocks (both on barrel) are only 6" center-to-center. Although there are a few differences,

I believe your rifle no. 1516604 was made in the same lot as my rifle no. 1516614. A third 30-in. Style "T" rifle has been reported in this range: no. 1516544.

SA annual reports show that 100 Style "T" rifles were manufactured, all in FY 1930. Most of these are listed in the DCM sales records in the 1314xxx serial range. However, a careful perusal of the SA Annual Reports published by Bill Brophy shows for FY 1937 (on pg. 293) the following item under Miscellaneous Spare Parts & Accessories, Etc.: "6 Rifles, U.S., cal. .30, H.B. Style 'T' 30" (select parts, assemble, target, and inspect". The serial numbers of your rifle and mine indicate FY 1937 production, and I believe that they were among the six referred to in that item. Research in the Ordnance files turned up a Manufacturing Requisition dated May 29, 1936, for "18 Rifles, U.S., cal. .30, M1903 Style 'T' Heavy service barrels (30"), telescopic sight blocks, globe front sights, Lyman (Receiver) rear sights, and N.R.A. type stocks with butt plate of the shotgun type". These were intended for use by service teams of the Regular Army in the 1936 National Matches. Twelve Style "T" rifles were on hand from previous Matches, so it was necessary to produce only six new ones (the old ones being rebarreled from 28" to 30" length). The same requisition called for "18 Telescopic sights, 8-power complete with bases and 1/4 minute click for above rifles"; these were specified in the correspondence to be Lyman Targetspot 'scopes. Springfield reported completion of this order on Aug. 12, 1936 (within FY 1937).

Recently I have seen several Colt manufactured M1911A1 .45 cal. pistols which are standard U.S. issued pistols of WW2 (1944) vintage. On the front strap of the grip is stamped SMP and a 4 digit number in 1200-1300 range. The slide and barrel are also stamped with this same number. I believe that SMP stands for Shanghai Municipal Police as these 45's are all recent imports from

I am familiar with the 1930's vintage commercial Colt .45's which were factory roll marked on the frame with "No ____ Shanghai Municipal Police" and have that same number on barrel and slide. These are (or can be) documented by the standard Colt research letter which shows shipment to an exporter for delivery to S.M.P. These guns were ordered at the time that W. E. Fairbairn was in charge of firearms training for S.M.P. and was developing his theory and practice on combat pistolcraft.

The U.S. issue M1911A1's marked SMP must have been part of some sort of U.S. aid effort to rearm the SMP after the Japanese occupation of Shanghai ended and before the Chinese Communists took over in 1949. I speculate that the Chinese Communists used many of these captured .45's against U.S./U.N. forces during the Korean War.

Have you or any of the readers uncovered any information on these?

C.H., Ohio

I have not seen anything on these pistols. I have had several inquiries concerning M1911A1 pistols sold or donated to the French, Greeks, and other foreign governments. However, the foreign military assistance files are voluminous; and even if you could find a record of transfer to a particular country, it is doubtful if the records would show details on markings or a particular municipal police force. Perhaps David Buehn or some other expert has some info on this?

Just thought you would like a little information on two USMC '03A1 Snipers which have recently turned up. Combining my 13 years experience with a few of my collector friends and the people at the USMC museum at MCRD San Diego, we have arrived at the conclusion that both of these rifles are 100% original.

1) M1903A1 N.M. # 1497214 4-37 S.A. S.G. # C3949, Unertl O-E marked pre-war bases. Bolt has been blued over the high polish, numbered bolt. Rifle was originally purchased by the owner, USMC Ret Maj. Bill Wilson, at Quantico, Va., in 1954. Cost was \$25.00 at the depot sales; still has the original sales receipt.

2) M1903A1 N.M. # 1526755 3-39 S.A. S.G.

under front base; exactly identical to above rifle. Rifle was brought in to a local gun store by an older gentleman who also sold them a 1911 Colt and an M1 carbine. Before I could question him about the rifle, he died of cancer.

Both of these rifles show 50 years of hard use. Most of the so-called USMC Snipers are in xln + condition. I'm sure they were all used and abused, judging by the condition of these two. The blued bolts are very interesting, kind of a light blue, almost like a 1941 blued M1911A1.

Also, neither rifle was with a scope when found.

I'm sure you will find the above info very interesting. Please feel free to give out my address & phone to anyone you know who would like more info on the above rifles. I also would appreciate any info you may be able to pass my way.

*Thanks for the info, Larry. The '03 rifles at the USMC Field Museum Activity Quantico were surveyed by Larry Miller several years ago, and the serial number data was added to our data base and published in vol. 3 of **Serial Numbers of U.S. Martial Arms**. Aside from several A4s, Larry listed only three U.S.M.C. Snipers in their collection: #s 1499608, 1526591, and 1526610. This museum is one of several that subscribe to the **U.S. Martial Arms Collector**, so we do have contacts there.*

I have a 1795 pattern musket, Harpers Ferry 1814 - with an obviously cropped bbl to 33 inches. Such is covered by some sources but find much disagreement - any opinions?

I can't give you a definite answer on that. The standard early H-F barrel was 45" long, and some shortened by only 3" have been dubbed "ships muskets" by some writers. There is also considered to have been a model known as the Model 1812 (Artillery), with 36" barrel; standard barrel length for the Model 1812 musket is 42". Flayderman says little about early H-F muskets, but he lists a Model 1795 Springfield with

33" barrel. The Harpers Ferry production records as summarized in Merritt Roe Smith's "Harpers Ferry Armory and the New Technology" do not list any flint muskets shorter than standard.

In my collection there is an '03 that came into my hands in early 1960. The intriguing thing is, I cannot document its past history since it has not made your serial number data in any past or present letters or your 3 published books.

It has the serial number 1093891 with a barrel date of 10-19. The metal is a black, non-reflective type, except the bolt which is bright with the serial number etched thereon. The rear sight leaf and windage gauge are polished bright. It has a heavy, dense grain, medium brown full pistol grip stock, with the serial number stamped on the butt stock, along with another number I cannot read. Inspector marks are behind cutoff slot and appear "--D", with a 1/4" P in a circle on the pistol grip behind the trigger guard. The buttplate is a very heavy checkered trap door type. Inside the butt is an O'Hare brass micrometer, and the front sight has the N.M. front sight cover attached.

The accuracy of this '03 is far superior to any of the 40 or 50 '03s I own, and the overall condition is absolutely mint.

Several '03 collectors have told me they think it's a National Match, but I'm skeptical. Incidentally, there is no star gauge on the muzzle, which I find confusing.

My own opinion is that the rifle might have been made up by an Army or National Guard rifle team for use at the Camp Perry matches, and maybe purchased by a competitor who used it.

H.M.D., Tenn.

It appears that you have a rifle originally made by Springfield for use in the 1919 or 1920 National Matches, then subsequently upgraded in the service by replacement of the straight stock with a pistol grip stock. As stated in Martial Arms Collector issues 57 and 58, it seems that there is no way to distinguish a stargauged barrel made before March, 1921. Starting in 1919, National Match rifles were given polished bolts and bolt ways, knurled butt plates, and grooved or checked triggers.

The reason I think this rifle was upgraded in the service (probably by a National Guard team) rather than Springfield, is that Springfield had a policy of replacing the barrel with one of current manufacture, on all NM rifles they overhauled.

Regarding .380 General Officer's Pistol #135482, is it still possible to get data through the Colt factory archives? If so, where do I write?

Yes, although the letter would likely only show that it is one of 1,500 shipped to the Government in late 1944. The address for Colt data is: Colt Historian, PO Box 1868, Hartford CT 06101. You can call them on 203/236-6311; possibly they will tell you whether they have any data on individual issues of the GO pistols.

ORIGINAL OWNER RESEARCH DOCUMENTED SPRINGFIELD M1903 DCM SALES RIFLES

PROMOTING the rewarding experience of collecting Springfield Rifles to the readers of the Springfield Research Service's excellent periodicals is certainly akin to preaching to the choir. The Springfield DCM Sales Rifles are the "rare gems" in the ongoing search for more and better. In a sense, these rifles come with a pedigree because authenticity is firmly established. This opens the door to an additional and enjoyable way of expanding collection activities, that is just now gaining credence among the Springfield collecting fraternity. This is researching the first owners of documented Springfield M1903 DCM Sales Rifles, in order to gain an insight into this person's "shooting" history. This effort can rapidly become a major hobby, in and of itself. This type of limited biography will be a valuable supplement to your collection records. The undocumented service rifle bought off a "grab bag" type of gun show table, can also have a very interesting history, but may be much more difficult to research. How many times have you heard the dealer say the rifle belonged to a recently deceased friend, but the widow desires to remain anonymous? If you try to press the dealer for more information, he may mistake you for an on-duty BATF Agent. Backtracking is a lot harder to work, and top down is the best approach. With a documented DCM Sales Springfield, you will start out with a copy of the original Ordnance bill-of-sale, that includes the rifle's identification data, the sales date, and a name and address. The task is formidable, as the event occurred anywhere from 52 to 70 years in the past. Most of these shooters have long since racked their rifle for the last time.

Unless you were fortunate enough to purchase your DCM sales rifle directly from a family member of the original owner, a shooting history of this person may be hard to come by. Be careful in telephone research, except to confirm the possibility of an address and name match. A letter or direct visit, if possible, are the best openers. Explain your intentions clearly. If you are

lucky enough to contact close relatives in telephone research, they might misunderstand your objectives and even think you may be trying to sell the firearm back to them, as some sort of lost and valuable heirloom which you have recovered. Here are some short descriptions of four typical case studies.

An M1903 National Match Rifle that was purchased directly from the Ordnance Officer at Camp Perry, during the National Matches, was the easiest to research. For these rifles, it is suggested that you write a letter to the NRA Competitive Division, or the Publications Division and Reference Library, in Herndon, Virginia. Explain that you are researching an original owner of a NM rifle, who most probably was a competitor in the National Matches of the corresponding year. The NRA Publication Division maintains bound volumes from the 1920s and 30s, of both the "National Rifleman" and "Arms and the Man". These will usually include complete listings of the various teams and match results. Request copies of this material for your collection records. Contact with the NRA revealed that the original owner of a 1925 NM rifle was actually a pistol competitor who scored third in his team category. His home address in Springfield, Massachusetts, is now a large parking lot. No one with a similar surname now lives in the general area or any nearby towns. This research ended there.

For those rifles that were originally purchased by one of the still existing Firearms or Ammunition companies, such as Remington and Winchester, it is suggested that you directly contact the company historian or person of similar responsibility. Information from a source such as this helped support the authenticity of a Springfield M1922MI rifle, in a .22 Hornet single shot configuration. This research ended at that point.

For the other rifle categories, a little field work is necessary. A recent visit in Providence, Rhode Island, to the address for an M1903A1 Service rifle, purchased from Springfield Armory via the DCM in 1936, yielded the home office for

a bank covering a whole city block. A visit to the city clerk's office resulted in the finding that the address was a physician's office in 1936. A number of people with the same surname stated that they had no knowledge of this individual. This research ended there.

A visit to a doctor's office in New London, Connecticut, last summer, unexpectedly but pleasantly revealed that his office was on the same short side street as that of the original owner of a Cal. .22 M2 purchased via the DCM in 1937. I had acquired this rifle only a short time before, but had not started any research. The name on the mailbox didn't match, but an elderly gentleman working on his lawn next door filled in some missing details. His neighbor left the area and went out West in 1955, but they were good friends and car pool buddies during the period of just before, during, and shortly after World War Two. He did not recall the .22 rifle, but stated that his neighbor was an ardent outdoor enthusiast and member of a rod and gun club in Old Saybrook, Connecticut. Conversations with friends

at the gun club provided the information that the original owner ran the club DCM programs during the late 30s. When he went West, he gave the .22 rifle to one of the small bore team coaches. The coach owned the .22 for another 35 years. When he passed away, the .22 together with several other favorite shooting irons were given to one of his club friends. This person promptly sold these firearms to one of the local gun stores. A phone call was the next step. The gun store owner would not provide any information, other than to confirm the source. Direct contact with the seller indicated that he did not know the original owner, who he said was before his time. He also stated that he didn't particularly like old Army guns, but was a little sorry he sold the Model 70 Winchester. The NRA Model Cal. .22 M2, Serial number 5588, by the way, is jet black parkerized with 100% metal, and the wood is just about mint. The NRA style stock is a presentation grade of dense, well figured American black walnut. The gap was closed all the way from top to bottom, and this research also ended there. §

M1-era Ordnance Notes

- Ten cal. .375 Magnum Win. M70 rifles were procured for the Army in Dec., 1940.

- Springfield reported that they produced 3,519,471 M1 rifles before production stopped in 1945 (it appears that the serial number on SA arms stood at about 3826XXX when WWII production ceased).

- There was quite a bit of trouble getting the correct hardness on M1 rifle rear sight elevating pinions and knobs, and many thousands had to be rehardened. These were identified by a single groove placed midway in the knurling.

- In Feb., 1954, Army Field Forces Board No. 3 requested to be furnished with five carbines modified to fire high-velocity cal. .22 cartridges.

- The Kollmorgen Optical Corp. supplied a

quantity of the Stith-Kollmorgen Telescopic Sight Model 4XD-USMC and corresponding mounts to the Marine Corps for use on the MC M1952 Cal. .30 Snipers Rifle. Army Field Forces Board No. 3 tested twelve different telescopes and six different mounts, issuing a report in March, 1954, recommending adoption of the Stith Bear Cub 4X 'scope and Pachmayr Lo-Swing mount. Based on this report, it was decided to designate the M84 'scope as Limited Standard.

- Benicia Arsenal was tasked to furnish 800 pistols for the 1954 National Matches. Development of a true National Match pistol started in Nov., 1954.

- Competition for selection of a new service pistol was conducted starting in Dec., 1954.

- The Navy transferred 44,565 .38 revolvers to the Army in Jan., 1955. §

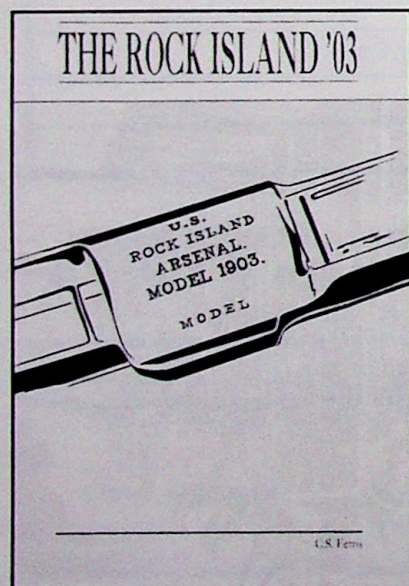

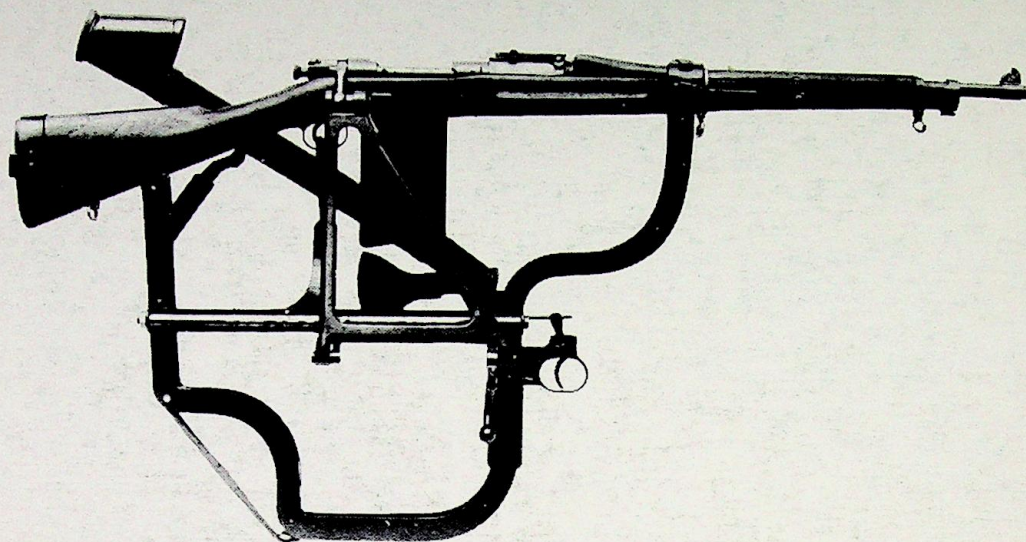
